How to apply for a 329 card in Hawaii



1. MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO SEE YOUR CERTIFYING PHYSICIAN/APRN

Your first appointment with your medical provider must be an in-person face-to-face assessment including a complete review of all applicable medical records.

2. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION ONLINE <https://medmj.ehawaii.gov>

Once submitted, your application will be certified by your physician/aprn and submitted to the patient registry for further processing.

Out-of-State patients - submit your states cannabis registration card and ID from the same state in lieu of seeing a provider in Hawaii.

we do not accept international medical cannabis registrations at this time



3. PATIENT REGISTRY APPROVAL

You will receive an email notification once your application has been approved. You may then log into your online account and print or save a copy of your 329 card to your mobile device.

IN-STATE PATIENTS:

If you are unable to complete the online application for any reason, please discuss submitting a "physician-initiated" application with your certifying medical provider.

IN-STATE FEES: NON-REFUNDABLE

1 YEAR - \$38.50; 2 YEAR RENEWAL - \$77.00

OUT-OF-STATE FEES: NON-REFUNDABLE

\$49.50 FOR EACH 60 DAY TERM
(2, 60 DAY TERMS IN A CALENDAR YEAR)

LIST OF ELIGIBLE DEBILITATING MEDICAL CONDITIONS

- Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis
- Cancer
- Glaucoma
- Epilepsy
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Rheumatoid Arthritis
- HIV/AIDS
- Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder

AND/OR the treatment of these conditions, or a chronic or debilitating disease or medical condition that produces one or more of the following:

- Cachexia/wasting syndrome
- Severe pain
- Severe nausea
- Seizures
- Severe and persistent muscle spasms

Medical Cannabis Use in Hawaii

MEDICAL USE RULES

- Grow no more than **10 plants** at a single registered location; each plant must be tagged with the patients registration number and expiration date (in-state patients only)
- Possess no more than **4 ounces** of usable cannabis
- Purchase medical cannabis from a dispensary
- Designate a caregiver (ratio 1:1)
- Must have your valid ID and 329 card on your person whenever in possession of medical cannabis (not having WiFi or Data is no excuse)
- No acquiring, possession, cultivation, use in public places
- No use in any way that “endangers the health or well-being of another person”
- Must be transported in sealed container, not be visible to public, & not removed from the container in public
- No protection of State laws if transported inter-island
- Patient registrations & grow sites subject to verification
- Complaints investigated by law enforcement
- All "Smoke Free" laws apply to medical cannabis (there are other methods of ingestion available)
- A general rule – if the entire “footprint” of the property is “smoke free”, registered in-state and out-of-state patients cannot smoke/vape
