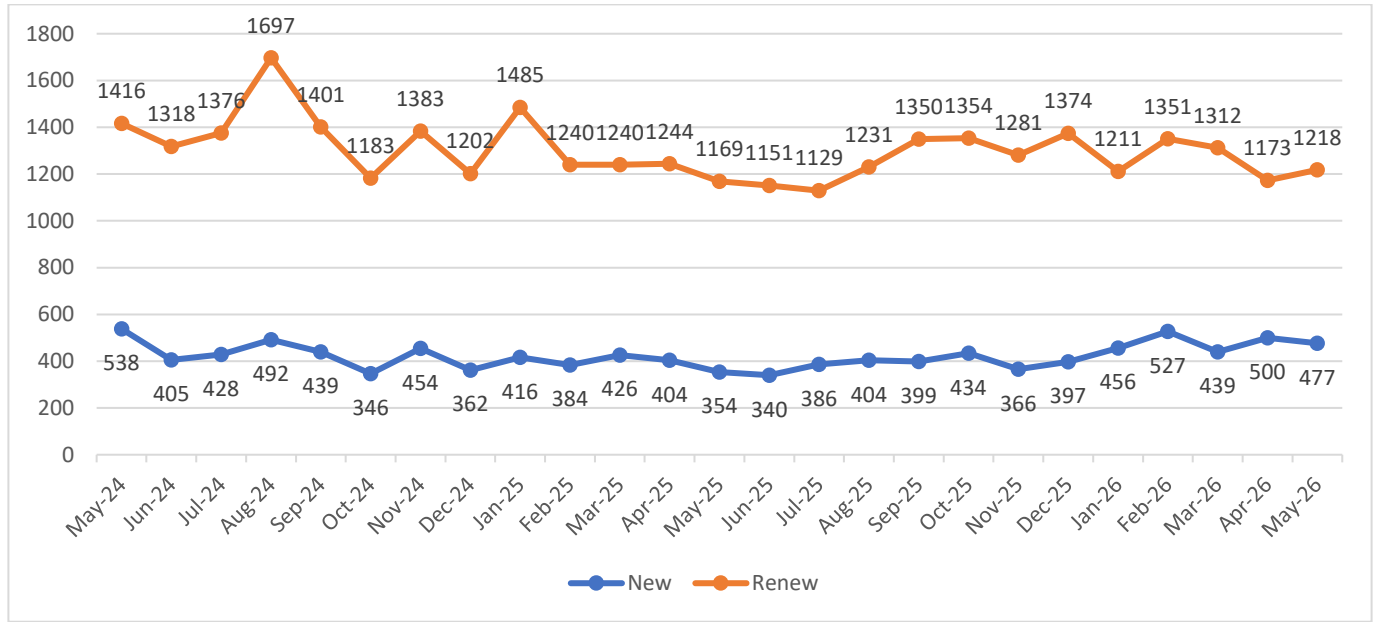

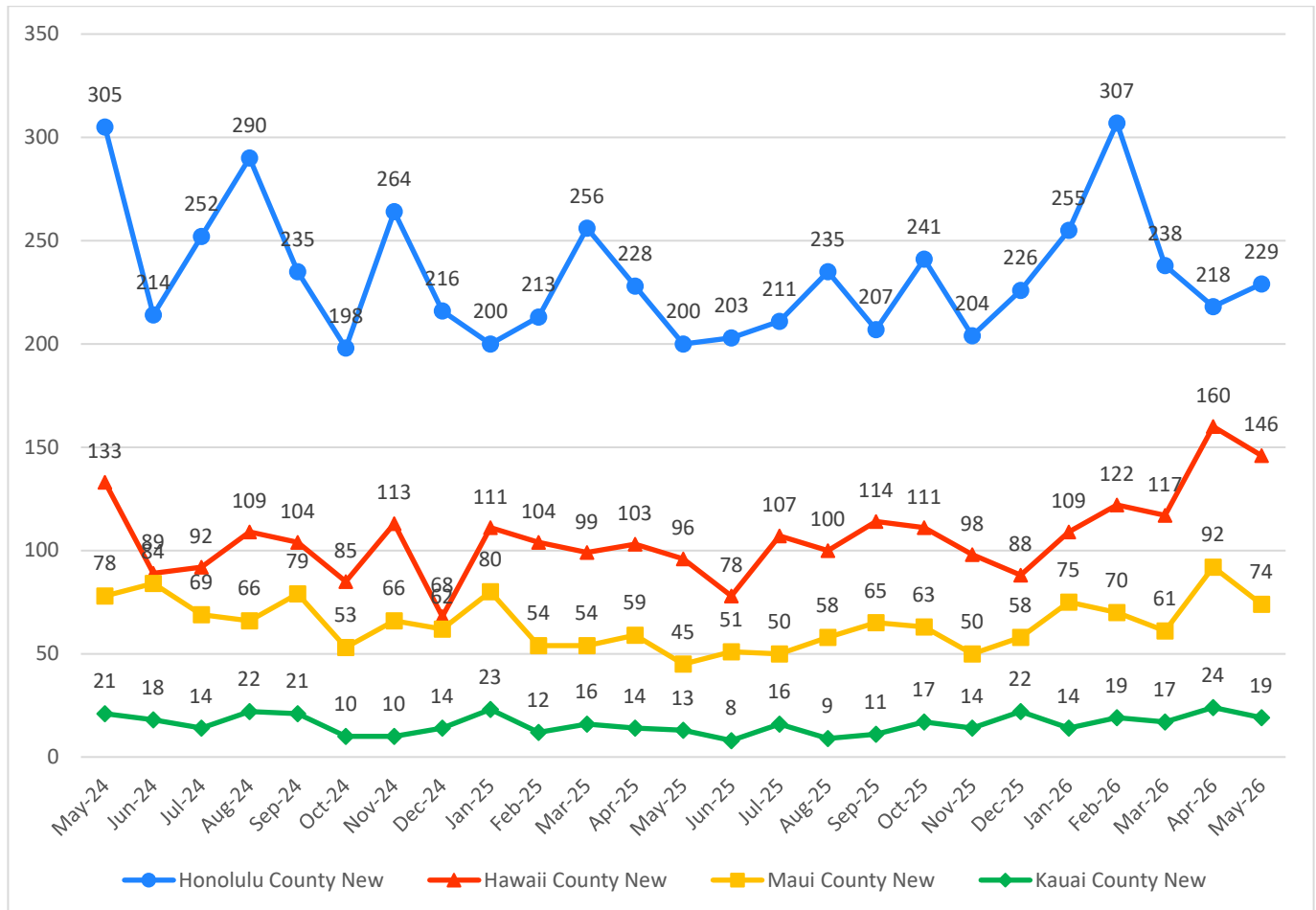

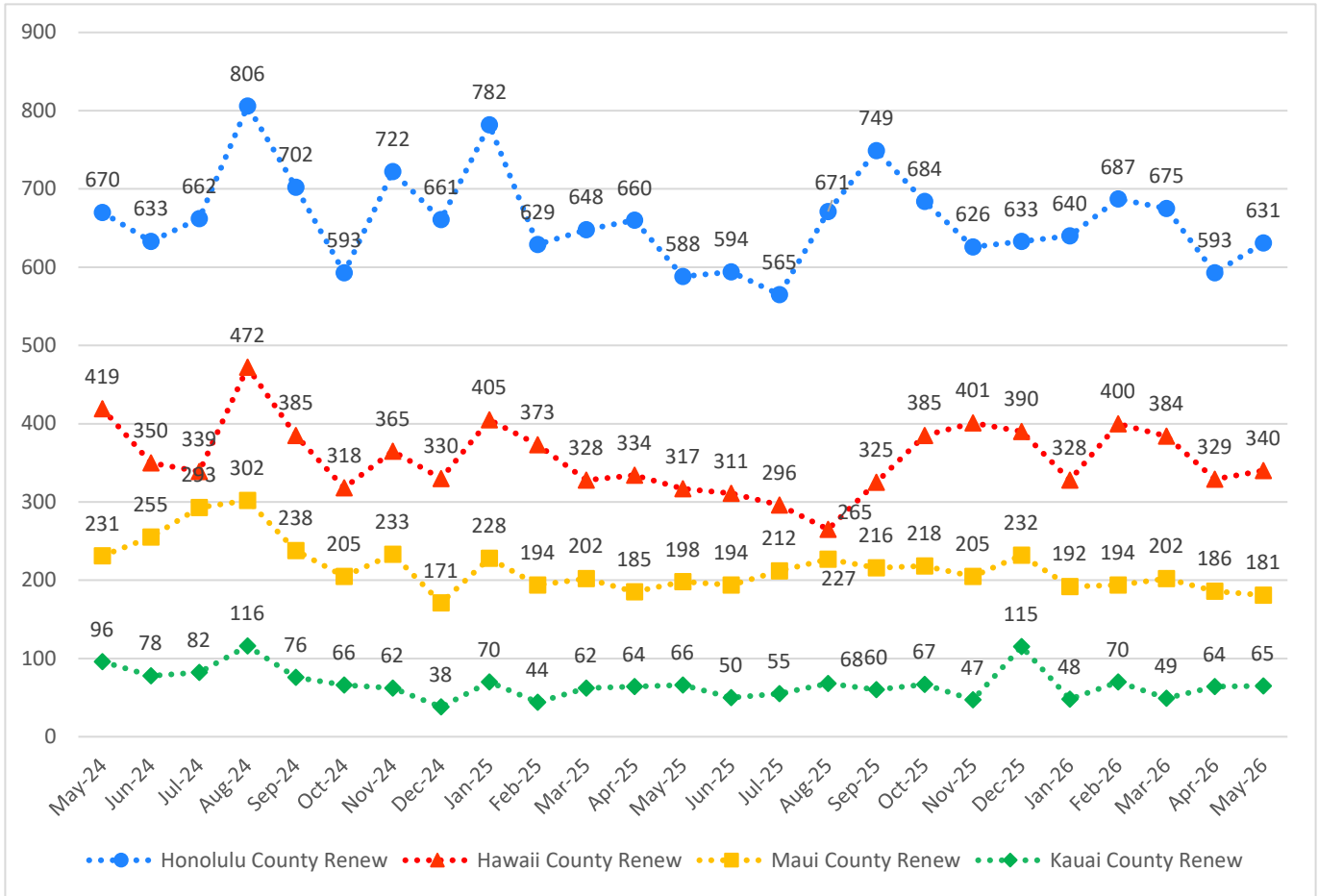
Graph 1. Number of Approved Applications: New Applications vs Renewal Applications, May 2024 – May 2026
