

Amendment to Chapter 11-160  
Hawaii Administrative Rules

1. Section 11-160-56, Hawaii Administrative Rules, is amended to read as follows:

"§11-160-56 Confidential information; exceptions. (a) All information received and records kept by the department for purposes of administering this chapter are confidential and not subject to disclosure except to:

- (1) Employees or agents of the department as necessary to perform their official duties under this chapter;
- (2) Federal, [State]state, or local law enforcement agencies for the purpose of verifying registration with the department pursuant to this chapter or for official law enforcement purposes;
- (3) [An individual] A person or entity pursuant to an order or subpoena from a court or agency of competent jurisdiction; [and]
- (4) A person or entity with the written permission of the qualifying patient or, if the qualifying patient is a minor or an adult lacking legal capacity, of the qualifying patient's parent, guardian, or person having legal custody[.];
- (5) Employees or agents of the State's medical marijuana dispensary system;
- (6) Employees or agents of the department's contracted computer software tracking system used within the State's medical marijuana dispensary system;
- (7) Medical marijuana dispensary system licensees as deemed necessary by the department for purposes of:
  - (A) Verifying the status of a person as a qualifying patient or primary caregiver; and



4. The amendments to chapter 11-160, Hawaii Administrative Rules, shall take effect ten days after filing with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor.
