**Environmental Health Services Offices to Close June 21-22
for Relocation to New Halawa Valley Location**

HONOLULU – The Hawaii State Department of Health (DOH) Environmental Health Services Division (EHSD) will be moving from their current location at 591 Ala Moana Boulevard to 99-945 Halawa Valley St. on June 21-22, 2016. During this transition, EHSD programs will be unable to provide normal services to the public and the regulated business community.

“We apologize for the inconvenience, but the temporary shutdown is necessary to ensure all phone lines and computers are set up and working properly and all appropriate files and documents have been transferred to the new facility before normal operations can resume,” said Lynn Nakasone, Environmental Health Services Division Chief.

Normal office operations will resume on June 23, 2016 at the new Halawa facility, and office telephone numbers will remain the same except for the Vector Control Program. The following programs will be closed on June 21-22:
