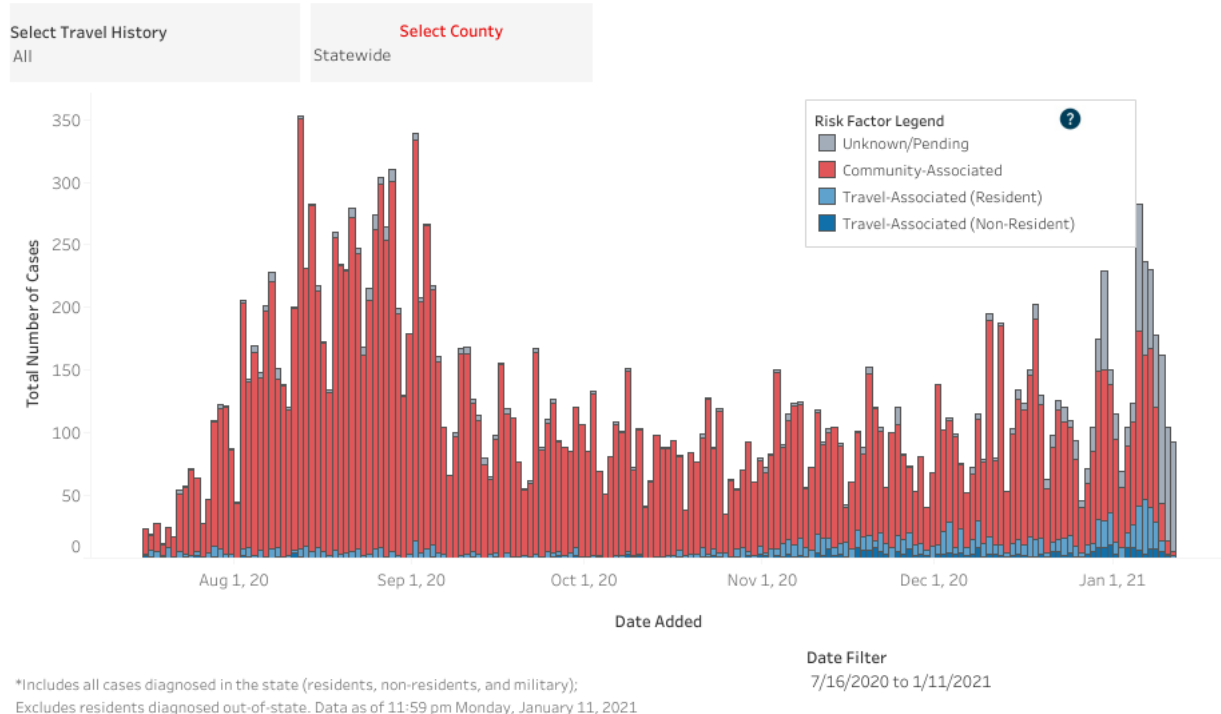

106 COVID-19 Cases and Three Deaths Reported

DOH reports 106 new cases of coronavirus today and three (3) additional deaths, raising the state's COVID-19 death toll to 312.

1 Man, 50-59 yrs, underlying conditions, hospitalized

Maui

1 Man, 60-69 yrs, underlying conditions, hospitalized
