Currently live with RAPIDai and Queen's is receiving images.

## **Castle Medical Center:**

Currently live with RAPIDai and Queen's is receiving images. Castle is upgrading its CT perfusion capability with a new CT scanner installation planned for September. Queen's began telestroke coverage of Castle Medical Center on June 19.

## **Kuakini Medical Center:**

Project remains on hold. IschemiaView RAPID team will be meeting with this site during a planned site visit in Hawaii projected for early September.

## **Kauai Veterans Memorial Hospital:**
