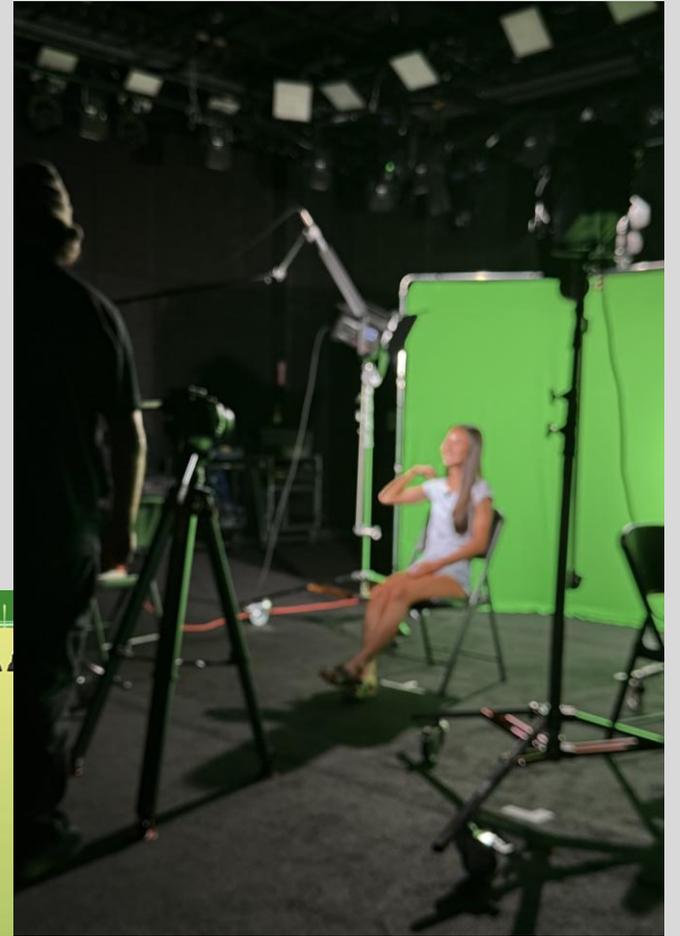

# Sample question - EVERYONE

- According to the Hawaii Concussion Law, When can an athlete return to play after sustaining a concussion?
  1. As soon as they report feeling fine
  2. Only after receiving medical clearance from a healthcare provider
  3. After resting 24 hours

# Sample Question – YOUTH ATHLETE

- How can you be a good teammate if you think your friend has a concussion?

# Sample Questions – Middle/HS Coaches

- What is a specific way coaches can help reduce the risk of concussion?
  1. By increasing the intensity of every drill
  2. By encouraging players to use their head more often
  3. By skipping the use of safety equipment to save
  4. By teaching age-appropriate, safe playing techniques

# Simple Questions – Officials

- When a concussion is suspected, your role is to
  1. Stop play
  2. Ensure that the athlete is removed from the game
  3. Ensure the athlete is evaluated by appropriate medical personnel
