The storage shall be in a staff controlled work cabinet-counter apart from either resident's bathrooms or bedrooms.</p> <p><u>FINDINGS</u> Resident #1, pharmacy bottle does not reflect order. Order reads, "Buspirone 5 mg tablet take <u>2 tablets</u> every seven days (Sunday)". Primary Care physician order for a more liberal diet dated August 4, 2016 reads “NAS/NCS but need follow-up with Nephrology”. The Type I ARCH policies and procedures shall provide that each individual admitted shall:</p> <p>Be fully informed orally and in writing, prior to or at the time of admission, and during stay, of services available in or through the Type I ARCH and of related charges, including any charges for services not covered by the Type I ARCH's basic per diem rate;</p> <p><u>FINDINGS</u> Resident #1, "Care Home Policy" dated upon admission reads, "rates range from \$150 per day and up to \$250 per day depending on level of care the resident needs". Resident #1, self-preserving certificate dated 1/21/6; however is dependent on wheel chair for mobility. 2. Resident #2, non self-preserving certificate dated, 6/30/16 and fire drill dated 4/05/16 reads, "Instructed ambulatory clients to walk to refuge area and assisted clients to refuge area (Resident #2) 3. Resident #3, observed in bed and non self-preserving certificate dated, 6/9/15. 4.
