A copy of the fire drill procedure and results shall be submitted to the fire inspector or department upon request;</p> <p><b><u>FINDINGS</u></b> No documented evidence of fire drills conducted at least quarterly within past twelve (12) months.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PART 1</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Correcting the deficiency after-the-fact is not practical/appropriate.
