

How to Apply for WIC



FOR MAUI RESIDENTS IMPACTED BY WILDFIRES

The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) waives the requirement for documents for those who are impacted by disasters. Physical presence can also be waived so that enrollments can be performed over the phone if an in-person appointment is not possible.

You may qualify if you are pregnant, breastfeeding, postpartum or have children under 5 years old.

Hawai'i WIC does not require proof of immigration status to determine eligibility.

To apply for WIC:

- 1. Visit the Maui WIC clinic at 781 Kolu St., Ste. A-1, Wailuku, HI 96793**
- 2. Call 808-984-8225 (best time to call is 8 a.m. to 4:15 p.m.)**
- 3. Fill out a pre-application online at hiwic.org/apply and WIC staff will contact you to set up an appointment.**
