

YOUTH CRISIS SERVICES

CARE Hawaii's mission is to provide a comprehensive array of behavioral health services to promote the physical, emotional, social, spiritual, recreational, and educational development of all identified consumers and their families/significant others.

What exactly do we do?

Here are the various services we can provide to you and the community:

- Lethality assessments (you may be concerned about a child's suicidal or homicidal thoughts, and are looking for recommendations and support on next steps)
- 30 day temporary case management
- Linkage to community providers (therapists, psychiatrists, treatment centers, Family Guidance Center)
- Therapeutic support either face-to-face or over the phone
- Initiate a safety plan
- You do not need to be suicidal to call! Sometimes we all just need a little extra support. Our services are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, at no cost to you.

Think getting help is too complicated?

Think again! All you need is the courage to call and ask for help. We are here for youth of all circumstances and backgrounds.

In 2017, 16% of high school students reported they seriously considered attempting suicide.

Our counselors are passionate about helping people! You are not a burden, and we would be happy to help you.

Need extra support?

Our staff is knowledgeable about community resources and is often able to link clients to services for a smooth transition.



Our services are located on Oahu; our crisis mobile outreach will come to you! Our goal is to respond to each call within 45 minutes, depending on location. Services are free!

Our Services

Each outreach can be conducted by either phone or a socially distanced outreach outside of the consumer's home. Outreaches take at least 1 hour, to include signing of and explanation of consents to the legal guardian. Outreaches last as long as the client is finding therapeutic value in it. This resembles a talk therapy session.

Following the outreach, each client is eligible for our 30 day follow up service. Typically, the initial CMO who outreached the client will continue to provide ongoing support and resources to the client and their family for 30 days. This can include referrals to community treatment providers, linkage to the Family Guidance Centers, or information regarding various treatment centers. Our CMO's
