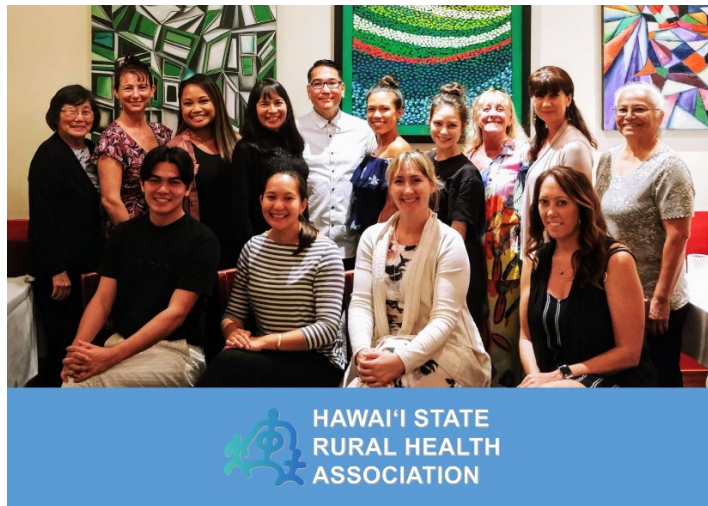




NATIONAL RURAL HEALTH DAY 2020
