§11-105-1 Purpose.

The purpose of this chapter is to establish fees for home health services on the islands of Lanai and Molokai provided by the Public Health Nursing Branch. This section implements the program of home health services pursuant to the provision of Title XVIII of the Social Security Act. §11-105-2 Definitions.

As used in this chapter:

"Skilled nursing services" means services provided by a registered professional nurse which requires assessment of health needs, plan of care, implementation of nursing intervention to effect a change in these health needs and evaluation of services provided to the patient.

"Visit" means a contact with a patient at the place of residence or in an office to provide skilled nursing or therapeutic services. A visit is calculated at 1-1/2 hours. [Eff. NOV 27 1981] (Auth: HRS §§321-9, 321-10, 321-92) (Imp: HRS §§321-9, 321-10, 321-92)
