ACCOUNT CREATION GUIDANCE

Aloha! Access to Hawaii TRAIN is open to individuals across Hawaii's public health community. An account is required to take courses in TRAIN. Accounts are created in two ways:

- Accounts are created for **regular Department of Health (DOH) employees and Medical Reserve Corps volunteers**. These individuals will receive their account information from the Hawaii TRAIN Administrator or Medical Reserve Corps Administrator – **do not** create your own account.
- **All others may create their own account**; this includes DOH 89-day hires, DOH contractors, interns, students, and members of the public.

To create your own account, please visit the [TRAIN Home Page](#), click on “Create account,” and follow the steps. After confirming your email, you will be able to update your profile, search the course catalog, and take courses of interest. **Thank you for joining our learning community!**
