The Hawaii Department of Health (DOH) has conducted a review of the proposed project for the Hana Water Systems, LLC in Maui County, in accordance with Hawaii's State Environmental Review Process, Chapter 343 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, Section 11-200-8 of the Hawaii Administrative Rules, and 40 CFR §35.3140 for CWSRF projects, or 40 CFR §35.3580 for DWSRF projects.

Project Description:

Decommission old 50,000-gallon water tank and construct two replacement 50,000-gallons water tanks to protect public health and update aging infrastructure.

DOH has determined that this project is eligible for an Exemption under Section 11-200-8(a), HAR, class 2, replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located generally on the same site and will have substantially the same purpose, capacity, density height, and dimensions as the structure replaced; and class 4, minor alterations in the conditions of land, water, or vegetation. Additionally, consultation with relevant agencies confirmed that the project will have no significant environmental impacts. Accordingly, the project is exempt from further substantive environmental review requirements under the above stated authorities.
