



Certification of Service Line Material Consumer Notification



Federal regulations require water systems notify all persons served by a service line classified as Lead, Galvanized Requiring Replacement (GRR), or Lead Status Unknown within thirty (30) days of completion of the baseline inventory and repeat the notification on an annual basis until the entire service connection is no longer a lead, GRR, or lead status unknown service line. For new customers, water systems shall also provide the notice at the time of service initiation.

Please certify the notification met the following criteria (by checking each line):

Notification was sent to all affected customers for the previous calendar year. (40 CFR (141.85(e)(2))

Note: starting Calendar Year 2028, notification shall be delivered by 30 days after the deadline for annual update to the service line inventory (typically March 1 for non-leap year and February 29 for leap year).

For all new customers in buildings served by lead, galvanized requiring replacement, or unknown service lines, a notice is provided at the initiation of service. (40 CFR 141.85(e)(2))

The notification included information about the material makeup of the service line (lead, galvanized requiring replacement, or an unknown material), including information about both the utility-owned sections and customer-owned sections of the service line where relevant. (40 CFR 141.85(e)(1))

The notification includes (pursuant to 40 CFR 141.85(e)(3)):

Steps a person can take to reduce lead exposure

For lead or GRR service lines, information about the opportunities to replace lead or GRR

For unknown service lines, ways to identify the material of unknown service lines

A statement that the consumer can request to have their tap water sampled (effective Nov 1, 2027)

The following EPA-mandated message (pursuant to 40 CFR 141.85(a)) was included in each notice:

For notices published between October 16, 2024 and November 1, 2027:

Health effects of lead. Exposure to lead in drinking water can cause serious health effects in all age groups. Infants and children can have decreases in IQ and attention span. Lead exposure can lead to new learning and behavior problems or exacerbate existing learning and behavior problems. The children of women who are exposed to lead before or during pregnancy can have increased risk of these adverse health effects. Adults can have increased risks of heart disease, high blood pressure, kidney, or nervous system problems.

For notices published on or after November 1, 2027:

Health effects of lead. There is no safe level of lead in drinking water. Exposure to lead in drinking water can cause serious health effects in all age groups, especially pregnant people, infants (both formula-fed and breastfed), and young children. Some of the health effects to infants and children include decreases in IQ and attention span. Lead exposure can also result in new or worsened learning and behavior problems. The children of persons who are exposed to lead before or during pregnancy may be at increased risk of these harmful health effects. Adults have increased risks of heart disease, high blood pressure, kidney or nervous system problems. Contact your health care provider for more information about your risks.

For Lead Service Lines and GRR notifications issued after November 1, 2027, the notification includes:

Information on how to obtain a copy of the service line replacement plan or view the plan on the internet.

A statement that the water system is required to replace its portion of a lead or galvanized requiring replacement service line when the property owner notifies the water system that they are replacing their portion of the lead or galvanized requiring replacement service line.

A statement that provides instructions for the customer to notify the water system if they disagree with the service line material categorization in the inventory.
