ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT March 2013

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

Kauai Members met on February 22, 2013 and heard from guest speaker Dr. Dileep G. Bal, Kauai District Health Officer, Hawaii Department of Health who offered a presentation "Community Health Needs Assessment – A Grassroots Kauai Model that Other Islands Should Follow". In addition, members heard from Brian Carter and Roy Goo (Assistant Professor, Department of Pharmacy Practice, College of Pharmacy, University of Hawaii Hilo) about the "Pharm-2-Pharm" – Health Care Innovation Award. Pharm-2-Pharm's aim is to "reduce annual medication-related hospitalizations and ER visit rates and total cost of care among elderly others at risk in rural Hawaii". Members are also continuing their work on the development of a community Assets Map.

Honolulu Members met on February 7, 2013. Dr. Joannie Dobbs, one of the University of Hawaii faculty who manages and provides the content for the "Got Nutrients?" project and website (www.gotnutrients.net), spoke about the importance of consuming all required essential nutrients and adequate calories as well as showing how nutrition affects both health maintenance and health care. The "Got Nutrients?" campaign was developed in partnership with HONSAC to provide basic "no nonsense" nutrition and health information to primarily seniors. The name "Got Nutrients?" was inspired by the basic concept that good health stems from meeting all essential nutrient needs. Dr. Dobbs explained what are health, nutrition, and the significance of homeostasis. She explained what an "essential nutrient" is and what happens when there is inadequate consumption of an "essential nutrient".
