ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT May 2013

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

Kauai

No meeting in April. Next meeting is July 8, 2013.

Honolulu

Members met on April 4, 2013. Captain Tom Duran gave an overview of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) National Quality Strategy (NQS). The purpose of NQS is to promote better health, health care and lower cost by collaboration across all health care sectors. Quality measurements will focus more on clinical outcomes and patient-reported experience measures. He also spoke about CMS program changes which included: Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, and Supplies (DMEPOS), the Electronic Health Record (EHR) Incentive Program and meaningful use. He briefly reviewed the Affordable Care Act and how it will strengthen Medicare, create affordable insurance exchanges, and end the Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) incentive and phase-in a value-based payment modifier to apply to the Medicare Fee for Service Payments. Finally, he gave an update on the progress of accountable care organizations and the Medicare Shared Savings Program nationally.
