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## ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT April 2017

### Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in March 2017. The next meeting will be on May 11, 2017.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on March 16, 2017. The members continued their work on the elder abuse project. The next meeting will be April 6, 2017.
- West Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) met on March 8, 2017. Dr. Cullen Hayashida, Ph.D., Eldercare Programs Advisor at St. Francis Healthcare System of Hawaii, gave a PowerPoint presentation on the topic "Killing 2 Birds with 1 Stone: Can Active Aging Help Address the Workforce Shortage and Healthcare Cost Crisis?" Copies of the presentation were distributed to those in attendance. The next meeting will be on June 14, 2017.
