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## ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT February 2017

### Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

**Kauai** The Kauai Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in January 2017. The next meeting will be on February 9, 2017.

**Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) did not meet in January 2017. The next meeting is February 2, 2017.

**West Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in January 2017. The next meeting will be on March 8, 2017.

#### **Windward Oahu**

The Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) meeting on January 19, 2017 was cancelled and will be rescheduled.

**Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in January 2017. The next meeting will be on March 3, 2017.

### Research and Statistics

The Research Statistician met with the staff of the Pacific Health Informatics and Data Center (PHIDC) of the University of Hawaii at Manoa on 01/06/2017 and 01/20/2017 to discuss issues related to the data management and analysis of the state's All Payer Claims Database (APCD). The next meeting has not been scheduled.

### **The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team**
