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## ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT January 2017

### Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) met on December 8, 2016. A discussion on "Effects of Corporatization on Quality and Accessibility of Care" was led by Brian Carter and Dr. Jim Raelson. The next meeting will be on February 9, 2017.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) did not meet in December 2016. The next meeting is February 2, 2017.
- West Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) met on December 14, 2016. A presentation on "Long Term Care Facilities and Services" was given by John McDermott, Hawaii State Long Term Care Ombudsman. Copies of the PowerPoint presentation were distributed. The next meeting will be on March 8, 2017.
- Windward Oahu** The Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in December 2016. The next meeting will be held during a site visit to the Koolauloa Community Health Center in Kahuku on January 19, 2017.

## **Research and Statistics**

The Research Statistician met with the staff of the Pacific Health Informatics and Data Center (PHIDC) at the University of Hawaii at Manoa on 12/02/2016 and 12/16/2016 to discuss issues related to future data management and analysis of the state's All Payer Claims Database (APCD). The 2016 health care utilization survey forms have been updated.

## **The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team**

An initial meeting of the project's State Health Data Analytics Working Group took place mid-December. The APCD legislative report was drafted, finalized, distributed, and posted, on time, with expert advice from the entire SHPDA team. SHPDA and the HHDC team completed the final draft of the interim administrative rules. On December 30, 2016 the annual progress report was submitted to the HHDC project's federal granting agency, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' Center for Consumer Information and Insurance Oversight. The HHDC team has been working very closely with the State's new Chief Information Security Officer, Vincent Hoang, to review and update the claims data security plan.
