ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT July 2016

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) meeting on June 24, 2016 was cancelled due to lack of quorum. Those in attendance did a tour of Tropic Care at Kauai Community College. The next meeting is tentatively set on August 18, 2016.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on June 2, 2016. Members continued their work on the elder abuse project. The next meeting will be July 7, 2016.
- West Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) met on June 15, 2016. Don Olden, CEO of Wahiawa General Hospital, gave a presentation on "Current Issues Facing Wahiawa General Hospital." Elections were held and the new council chair is Jill Tamashiro, with Emelyn Kim serving as vice chair. Copies of the old bylaws and proposed amendments were distributed for discussion at the next meeting. The next meeting will be on August 17, 2016.
- Windward Oahu** The Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in June 2016.
- Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in June 2016. The next meeting will be held on Molokai on July 8, 2016.
- Hawaii** The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) was scheduled to meet on June 7, 2016 to tour the Tropic Care at Keaau High School. The meeting was cancelled due to lack of quorum. The next meeting has not been scheduled yet.

Research and Statistics

The response rate for the 2015 Utilization Survey was at 89.5% as of 06/30/2016. A few health care providers requested additional time for completing the survey. While waiting for more surveys to come, the research statistician is working to review and verify the information submitted by the health care providers, and to enter data for analysis. Additional efforts were made to contact the health care providers who had not submitted their 2015 Utilization Survey by the May 30 deadline.
