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ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT October 2017

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in September 2017. The next meeting will be on November 9, 2017.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on September 7, 2017. Ms. Nalani Aki, MPA, County Executive on Aging, City & County of Honolulu, Elderly Affairs Division made a presentation on "The ABC's of the ADRC." The next meeting will be October 5, 2017.
- West Oahu and Windward Oahu**
The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) met on September 13, 2017. A site visit to the clinics of the Ko'olauloa Health Center – the Kahuku Clinic, Red Raider Health Center, and the Hau'ula Clinic – was conducted prior to the meeting. A briefing/presentation on the history, programs and future plans of the Ko'olauloa Health Center was given by Terrence Aratani, CEO. Questions were entertained following the presentation. The next meeting will be on December 13, 2017.
- Tri-Isle** The meeting of the Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) that was scheduled on September 8, 2017 was cancelled due to the non-availability of the invited speaker. The next meeting will be on December 1, 2017.
- Hawaii** The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) did not meet this month. The next meeting is scheduled for October 3, 2017.

Research and Statistics

As of 09/25/2017, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for Calendar Year 2016 was at 95.2%. The research statistician is working to review and verify the information submitted by the health care providers, and to perform data analysis.

The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team

The HHDC Team received approval for one-year no-cost grant extensions. Federal funds will be available to support the project through September 2018. The interim administrative rules are being prepared for final submission to the Governor for review and approval. The Data Submission Guide is undergoing final revisions.
