ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT September 2017

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

Kauai The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) met on August 10, 2017. Dr. Norman Okamura, PhD, Director, TASI/Pacific Health Informatics and Data Center, University of Hawaii at Manoa College of Social Sciences, Social Science Research Institute, gave a presentation on "The Value of Claims and Clinical Data Warehouses in Assessing Community Health Challenges and Needs." Dr. Okamura entertained questions during and after his presentation. Copies of the presentation were distributed. The next meeting will be on November 9, 2017.

Honolulu The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on August 3, 2017. The Elder Abuse Project finally received sufficient funding to go forward with its public awareness prevention campaign. Members worked on the public service announcement scripts. The next meeting will be on September 7, 2017.

West Oahu and Windward Oahu

The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in August 2017. The next meeting will be on September 13, 2017.

Tri-Isle The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in August 2017. The next meeting will be on September 8, 2017.

Hawaii The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) did not meet this month. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for October 3, 2017.

Research and Statistics

As of 08/25/2017, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for Calendar Year 2016 was at 91.3%. The research statistician continues to review and verify the information submitted by the health care providers, and to perform data analysis. Health care providers who had not submitted their 2016 Utilization Survey by the June 30 deadline were contacted by emails and phone calls regarding the submission of the survey.

The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team

The HHDC Team prepared and submitted requests for grant budget modifications and one-year no-cost grant extensions. The interim administrative rules are being prepared for final submission to the Governor for review and approval.
