Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in January 2018. Its next meeting will be on February 8, 2018.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on January 4, 2018. Ms. Tandi Nelson-Brooks, RN, MPH, of the Veteran's Affairs Pacific Islands Health Care System, provided an overview of their telehealth program. The next meeting will be February 1, 2018.
- West Oahu and Windward Oahu**
- The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) met on January 10, 2018. Keith Ridley, Office of Health Care Assurance, Department of Health, gave an update on licensed care homes and nursing homes inspection procedures. Questions were entertained before and during the presentation. The next joint meeting will be on March 7, 2018.
- Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in January 2018. The next meeting will be on March 2, 2018.
- Hawaii** The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) met on January 23, 2018. The members decided to submit a proposal for a grant to support the oral health prevention education project for seniors in Hawaii County. The next meeting will be March 27, 2018.

Research and Statistics

SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for Calendar Year 2017 was distributed to health care facilities/providers in January 2018. Health care facilities/providers are asked to complete the survey and return it to SHPDA by May 31, 2018. A link was also provided for accessing the instructions and survey forms at SHPDA website.

The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team

The interim administrative rules are awaiting approval from the Governor. After receiving the Governor's approval, they will be filed with the Lieutenant Governor's office.

The project team has been working with representatives from HMSA, CVS, HDS, and VSP in preparation for data submission.

House Bill 2361 and its companion bill Senate Bill 2788 were introduced in the legislature by way of the Governor's Package. The bills establish positions and funding within Med-QUEST for the HHDC project to continue beyond the federal grant.
