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## ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT May 2018

### Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

**Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in April 2018. The next meeting will be on July 12, 2018.

**Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on April 5, 2018. Ms. Dianne Okumura, former Branch Chief of the Office of Healthcare Assurance at the Hawaii Department of Health and now a Consultant, made a presentation entitled the "The Face of Long-term Care". The next meeting will be May 3, 2018.

### **West Oahu and Windward Oahu**

The West Oahu and Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Councils (WOSAC/WISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in April 2018. The next meeting will be on May 9, 2018.

**Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in April 2018. The next meeting will be on May 4, 2018.

**Hawaii** The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) met on April 24, 2018. The preventive oral health senior project received grant funds from the Hawaii Dental Service Foundation. The members reviewed and discussed the proposed project tasks necessary to start the implementation of the project. The next meeting was tentatively scheduled for May 29, 2018.

### Research and Statistics

As of 04/30/2018, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2017 was at 29.5%. The deadline to submit the 2017 utilization survey is May 31, 2018. Reminders will be sent to health care providers who have not submitted the

survey via email or fax during the first week of May. Additional reminders may be sent to health care providers prior to the deadline if needed.

### **The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team**

House Bill No. 694 HD2 SD1 CD1 was voted on and passed out of conference. The bill then passed third reading in both chambers, and was sent to the Governor for signature.

In preparation for a federal grant no-cost extension request, a special project extension has been requested for the HHDC positions and accounts.

The CIO approved project readiness for submission test data.

On April 26, 2018, the HHDC Steering Committee held its first public meeting. The project's technical partner, the team at the Pacific Health Informatics Data Center, was introduced. The HHDC by-laws were also adopted.
