Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

Kauai The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in May 2018. The next meeting will be on July 12, 2018.

Honolulu The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on May 3, 2018. Dr. Michael Cheang, Associate Professor of Human Development and Family Studies at the University of Hawaii at Manoa, made a presentation entitled, "Evidence-based Decisions vs. Insights to Consider When Crafting Policies for Caregiving Matters in Hawaii." The next meeting will be June 7, 2018.

West Oahu and Windward Oahu

The West Oahu and Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Councils (WOSAC and WISAC) had a joint meeting on May 9, 2018. Dr. Margaret Perkinson, Director of the University of Hawaii Center on Aging, gave a PowerPoint presentation on the history, purposes and activities of the Center. Dr. Perkinson invited the SAC to provide suggestions and other input for the betterment of the Center. Questions were entertained during and after the presentation. The next meeting will be on October 10, 2018.

Tri-Isle The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) did not meet due to lack of quorum. The group however decided to proceed with the presentation since the speaker was present. Karen Holt, executive director of Molokai Community Services Council, gave a presentation on "Adverse Childhood Experiences and Health." A handout titled The ABCs of Trauma-Informed Care was distributed. The next meeting will be on August 9, 2018.

Hawaii The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) did not meet this month. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for July 24, 2018.

Research and Statistics

As of 05/31/2018, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2017 was at 68%. The research statistician is working to review and verify the information submitted by the health care providers, and to enter data for analysis. Health care providers who did not submit their 2017 Utilization Survey by the May 31 deadline will be contacted by emails and/or phone calls regarding their submission. Some health care providers asked for more time to complete the survey.

The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team

The HHDC/APCD Steering Committee met on May 24, 2018. The University of Hawaii Pacific Health Informatics and Data Center Research Program presented an overview of the draft annual data plan. The overview provided the HHDC/APCD project goals for the upcoming year and described the activities and objectives that will support data protection, data collection, data management and maintenance, data analysis, and reporting and publication. The steering committee members will review the draft annual data plan.
