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ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT August 2018

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

Kauai The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) met on July 12, 2018. Ms. Sue Radcliffe (SHPDA), Mr. Jun Colmenares (SHPDA), and Mr. Johnny Yago (KAEA) gave a report on their presentation at the 2018 ASA Aging in America Conference held in San Francisco on March 25-29, 2018. In addition, Mr. Tony Benabese and Mr. Alfred Herrera of the Hawaii Health Data Center Project gave an update on the status of the All-Payer Claims Database (APCD). A Q&A period followed the presentations and copies of a handout were distributed. The next meeting will be on October 11, 2018.

Honolulu The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on July 5, 2018. Mr. Scott Morishige, the Governor's Coordinator on Homelessness, provided an overview of the Hawaii State Framework to Address Homelessness. He also discussed how the State's goal would be achieved, the identification of three leverage points, and the strategies and tactics that were and are currently being implemented. The next meeting will be August 2, 2018.

West Oahu and Windward Oahu The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in July 2018. The next joint meeting will be on August 8, 2018.

Tri-Isle The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in July 2018. The next meeting will be on August 9, 2018.

Hawaii The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) met on July 24, 2018. The members reviewed CON Proposal #18-02 submitted by the Hilo Medical Center: Establishment of Interventional Cardiac Catheterization Service. The members also reviewed what project tasks were completed for the preventive oral health senior project and what additional work was needed. The next meeting was tentatively scheduled for August 28, 2018.

Research and Statistics

As of 07/31/2018, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2017 was at 86.6%. The research statistician is working to verify the information submitted by the health care providers and perform data analysis. She will continue to contact health care providers about surveys that have not been submitted or data queries that have not been answered.

The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team

On July 12, 2018, the HHDC Project Team provided a project status update and a review of the SHPDA Annual Data Plan to members of the Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council.

The latest draft of SHPDA Med-QUEST Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for the submission of data was reviewed and edited. The project intends to finalize and execute the MOA in August 2018.
