Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in February 2019. The next meeting will be on April 11, 2019.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on February 7, 2019. The members continued work on their "Aging in Place" project. The next meeting will be March 7, 2019.

Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) met on February 13, 2019. Mr. Rich Bettini, President and CEO of Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center, gave a presentation on "WCCHC: Current and Future Plans." Questions were entertained during and after the presentation. A site visit was conducted after the meeting. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for April 10, 2019 or May 15, 2019.
- Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in February 2019. The next meeting will be on March 8, 2019.

Research and Statistics

SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2018 was distributed to health care facilities/providers in February 2019. Health care facilities/providers were asked to complete the survey and return it to SHPDA by May 31, 2019. As of February 28, 2019, the response rate for the survey was 14.7%.

The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team

The HHDC Steering Committee met on February 28, 2019.

SHPDA Medicare Advantage Bills: HB1011 was not heard. HB578 HD1 was heard and passed unamended by the House Committee on Judiciary. The bill was referred to the House Committee on Finance. SB1237 was heard and passed with amendments by the Senate Committee on Consumer Protection and Health. The amended bill, SB1237 SD1, was referred, heard, and passed unamended by the Senate Committee on Judiciary. It is anticipated that the Senate version will crossover.
