Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

Kauai The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in March 2019. The next meeting will be on April 11, 2019.

Honolulu The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on March 7, 2019. The first topic area for the "Aging in Place" Project will be medication management. The next meeting will be April 4, 2019.

Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in March 2019. The next meeting will be on May 9, 2019.

Tri-Isle The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) met on March 8, 2019. Maui County Mayor Mike Victorino discussed with the group various health issues facing the county. The next meeting will be on May 17, 2019.

Hawaii The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) was scheduled to meet on March 19, 2019 but was cancelled due to lack of quorum. The next meeting is not scheduled yet.

Research and Statistics

As of March 31, 2019, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2018 was at 18.6%.

The team continues to work with the data reporters on their submissions. As of March 31, 2019, the following data has been received:

The team is working with the Department of Human Services' Med-Quest Division to assist with program transition and continuity. The federal grants supporting the HHDC ended on March 31, 2019.

Through Act 55 (2018) the newly created Med-QUEST Health Analytics Office has assumed the responsibility for supporting the HHDC. Mr. Alfred Herrera started working at the newly created Health Analytics Office on March 28, 2019.

SHPDA Medicare Advantage Bills: SB1237 SD1, It passed Third Reading in the Senate and crossed over to the House on March 5. SB1237 SD1 was heard, amended and passed by the Health committee and Human Services committee in a joint hearing. The bill, now known as SB1237 SD1HD1, was heard and passed unamended by the Finance committee.

It is anticipated that in April the bill will pass Third Reading in the House; be transmitted to and received by the Senate; be disagreed by the Senate; and then referred to conference committee for version reconciliation and agreement.
