ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT August 2019

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in July 2019. The next meeting will be on September 12, 2019.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on July 11, 2019. The members began work on the scripts for the next two public service announcements of the medication management series. The next meeting will be August 1, 2019.
- West Oahu and Windward Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in July 2019. The next meeting will be on August 14, 2019.
- Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in July 2019. The next meeting will be on August 12, 2019.
- Hawaii** The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) met on July 23, 2019. Members met with Dr. Hawken Shields and Ms. Liz Carroll of West Hawaii Mental Health Center. The next meeting will be August 27, 2019.

Research and Statistics

As of July 31, 2019, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2018 was at 92.2%. The research statistician continues to review and verify the information submitted by the health care providers, and to enter data for analysis. Health care providers who did not submit their 2018 utilization survey by the May 31 deadline were contacted via emails and/or phone calls regarding their submission.

The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team

Current Data Submission Status (07/31/19): Of the five EUTF Health Plan Reporters, four are in the Production Test phase and one is in Production submission. EUTF is also in Production submission.

- a. CVS Health: New rounds of Production Test files are in process and under review.
- b. EUTF: Production files to December 31, 2017 have been submitted.
- c. Hawaii Dental Service: Production files continue to be submitted on time.
- d. Kaiser: Data quality and validation reports were provided back to Kaiser. Kaiser is reviewing and will submit updated Production Test files.
- e. Hawaii Medical Service Association: New rounds of Production Test files are in process and under review.
- f. VSP Vision Care: Data quality and validation reports were provided back to VSP. VSP is working to submit new Production Test files by mid-August.
- g. Medicare Fee-for-Service: Currently possess 2010-2014 data (old version); working with CMS to receive 2010-2017 data (updated version).
