Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not have a scheduled meeting in August 2019. The next meeting will be on October 10, 2019.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on August 1, 2019. The members completed the scripts for the next two public service announcements of the medication management series. The next meeting will be September 12, 2019.
- West Oahu and Windward Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) met on August 14, 2019. Darryl Shutter, Regulatory Branch Chief of the State Health Planning & Development Agency, gave a presentation on the "Certificate of Need (CON) Process." Handouts were distributed. The next meeting will be on November 13, 2019.
- Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) met on August 12, 2019. Wesley Lo, CEO, Hale Makua Health Services, gave a presentation on "Aging Resources and Challenges in Maui." The next meeting will be on October 11, 2019.
- Hawaii** The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) on August 27, 2019. Members met with Ms. Elena Cabatu, Director of Marketing, Public and Legislative Affairs for Hilo Medical Center, Hale Ho'ola Hamakua, and Kau Hospital. The next meeting will be October 8, 2019.

Research and Statistics

As of August 31, 2019, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2018 was at 96.1%. The research statistician continues to review and verify the information submitted by the health care providers, and to enter data for analysis. Health care providers who did not submit their 2018 utilization survey by the May 31 deadline were contacted by emails and/or phone calls regarding their submission.

The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team

Current Data Submission Status (08/31/19): Of the five EUTF Health Plan Reporters, four are in the Production Test phase and one is in Production submission. EUTF is also in Production submission.

- a. CVS Health: New rounds of Production Test files have undergone review. Working with CVS to review quality reports.
- b. EUTF: Production files to December 31, 2017 have been submitted.
- c. Hawaii Dental Service: Production files continue to be submitted on time.
- d. Kaiser: Data quality and validation reports were provided back to Kaiser. Kaiser is reviewing and will submit updated Production Test files.
- e. Hawaii Medical Service Association: New rounds of Production Test files have undergone review. Working with HMSA to review quality reports.
- f. VSP Vision Care: New rounds of Production Test files have been submitted and are currently under review.
- g. Medicare Fee-for-Service: Currently possess 2010-2014 data (old version); are working with CMS to receive 2010-2017 data (updated version).
