Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) met on January 9, 2020. Dr. Janet Berreman, Kauai District Health Officer; Jen Chahanovitch, President and CEO of Wilcox Medical Center, and Michael Dahilig, representing Kauai Mayor Derek Kawakami, led a panel discussion on "Kauai's Wellness Partnership."
