Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai County Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) met on September 10, 2020 via Zoom. Lauren Guest, MPH, Public Health Preparedness Planner, Kauai District Health Office, gave a presentation on "Kauai's COVID19 CASPER Report." The next Zoom meeting will be on November 12, 2020.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) did not meet in September 2020. The next meeting has not been scheduled.
- West Oahu and Windward Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) and Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) did not meet in September 2020. The next Zoom meeting will be on October 21, 2020.
- Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) met on September 11, 2020 via Zoom. Andrew Aoki of the Islander Institute gave a presentation on the "2019 Community Health Needs Assessment." The next Zoom meeting has not been scheduled.
- Hawaii** The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) did not meet in September 2020. The next meeting has not been scheduled.

Research and Statistics

As of September 30, 2020, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2019 was at 90.3%. The fourth round of overdue notification was sent to health care facilities/providers that/who had not submitted their survey by the deadline of May 31, 2020. Some health care facilities/providers requested further extension for submission, citing the impact of COVID-19.

The Hawaii Health Data Center (HHDC) Project Team

Current Data Submission Status (9/30/2020): Of the five EUTF Health Plan Reporters, one is in the Production Test phase and four are in Production submission. EUTF is also in Production submission.

1. CVS Health: Q2 2020 data accepted, anticipating submission of Q3 2020 data in October.
2. EUTF: Received additional Production files for the period of July - August 2020.
3. Hawaii Dental Service: Q2 2020 data accepted, anticipating submission of Q3 2020 data in October.
4. Kaiser: Submitted updated Production test files. Working with Kaiser to review Production test quality reports and update data. Having ongoing meetings with Kaiser data team to resolve remaining issues. Working with Kaiser to get ME, MC, PV data into production cycle, goal is to do one last test in October then move into production. PC files to be initiated thereafter.
5. Hawaii Medical Service Association: Q2 2020 data accepted, anticipating submission of Q3 2020 data in October.
6. VSP Vision Care: Completed Production test. Received first round of production files, pending validation and review for acceptance.
7. Medicare Fee-for-Service: Currently possess 2010-2014 data (old version), submitted request for additional data 2010-2018 data (updated version), pending CMS final approval.
