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ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT March 2022

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Kauai** The Kauai Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) did not meet in February 2022. The next meeting is scheduled for March 17, 2022.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Planning Council (HONSAC) met on February 3, 2022. Project plans for 2022 were narrowed down to 1) Digital Literacy for Kupuna, 2) Healthcare Literacy, and 3) Language Literacy. Speakers for future meetings were discussed and requested. SHPDA reported being in contact with the Hawaii State Hospital staff to reschedule a site visit; the January 2022 site visit was cancelled due to the increase in Omicron cases. Members were encouraged to review updates to the Sunshine Law on the Office of Information Practices website. The next meeting is scheduled for March 3, 2022.
- West Oahu and Windward Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WISAC) and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council (WOSAC) did not meet in February 2022. The next meeting is scheduled for March 16, 2022.
- Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council (TISAC) met on February 4, 2022. Discussions continued on potential projects for 2022. Speakers on current regional priorities were suggested by Members. Members were encouraged to review updates to the Sunshine Law on the Office of Information practices website. The next meeting is scheduled for May 13, 2022.
- Hawaii** The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council (HCSAC) met on February 15, 2022. Discussions continued on project focusing on accessing health care services on Hawaii Island. The Project will provide short Public Service Announcements focusing on – Navigating the Health Care System. The Project proposal (draft) was discussed and will be further reviewed at the next meeting. Members were encouraged to review updates to the Sunshine Law on the Office of Information practices website. The next meeting will be held on March 22, 2022.

As of February 28, 2022, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2021 was at 11.3%. Health care facilities/providers were asked to complete the survey and return it to SHPDA by May 31, 2022.
