Dear Mr. Cunningham:

The State Health Planning and Development Agency has evaluated Wahiawa General Hospital's Certificate of Need application #22-05A for the deletion of 93 Skilled Nursing Facility/Intermediate Care Facility beds, at no capital cost.

Pursuant to Title 11, Chapter 186 of the Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), the Agency finds and determines that:

- (a) The proposal is eligible for administrative review as it meets one or more of the criteria in Subsection 11-186-99.1(b), HAR.
- (b) The applicant, Wahiawa General Hospital, has proven by a preponderance of the evidence that its proposal meets the Certificate of Need criteria in HAR 11-186-15(a).
- (c) There is no compelling public interest which will be served by requiring the application to go through the standard review process.

As required under Section 323D-43(b), Hawai'i Revised Statutes (HRS), the Agency determines and concludes that:

- 1. There is a public need for this proposal.
- 2. The cost of this proposal will not be unreasonable in light of the benefits it will provide and its impact on health care costs.

Accordingly, the State Health Planning and Development Agency hereby APPROVES and ISSUES a Certificate of Need to Wahiawa General Hospital for the proposal described in Certificate of Need application #22-05A. There is no capital expenditure authorized under this approval.
