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ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT September 2022

Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs) Activities

- Hawaii** The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council met on August 16, 2022. Lisa Grove, President and CEO of Grove Insight and Lisa Rantz, Executive Director, Hilo Medical Center Foundation, provided a presentation on the "Access to Care Project", followed by a discussion. Due to time constraints, the discussion on the "Accessing Health Care Services on Hawaii Island" project will resume at the next HCSAC meeting. The next meeting is scheduled for September 27, 2022.
- Honolulu** The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on August 11, 2022. The HONSAC Bylaws and Priorities were presented followed by a discussion on the recruitment of new members, the need to establish subcommittees and member involvement on subcommittees. The next meeting will be on September 8, 2022.
- Kauai** The Kauai Subarea Health Planning Council (KCSAC) met on August 19, 2022. The KCSAC Bylaws and Priorities were presented followed by a discussion on potential projects and the recruitment of new members. Meeting frequency will increase from every other month to every month. The next meeting will be on September 15, 2022.
- Tri-Isle** The Tri-Isle Subarea Health Planning Council met on August 12, 2022. New officers were elected. Information on the Certificate of Need process were presented and the discussion on potential projects continued. Members were informed of the Sunshine Law update as Act 264, effective July 8, 2022 and were encouraged to review details on the Office of Information Practices website. The next meeting is scheduled for November 18, 2022.
- West Oahu and Windward Oahu** The West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council and the Windward Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council did not meet in July 2022. The next meeting is scheduled for September 21, 2022.

As of August 31, 2022, the response rate for SHPDA's annual health care utilization survey for calendar year 2021 was at 93.3%. The research statistician is working to prepare the 2021 Health Care Utilization Report while continuing to contact health care facilities/providers that/who had yet to submit their surveys or to respond to data queries.
