Aloha to all. The State Health Planning and Development Agency (SHPDA) is pleased to present this Health Care Utilization Report for the Year 2022. The report presents current data on health care utilization and availability from both public and private health care facilities in Hawaii.

This fulfills one of SHPDA's Legislatively mandated responsibilities to collect up-to-date and accurate data on access to and usage of health care services statewide. This is necessary for assuring appropriate future availability of, and planning for high-quality and adequate health care services and infrastructure in Hawaii for an aging population here, taking into account both geographic population and service needs changes, and an evolving health care delivery system.

We greatly appreciate all those many facilities that submitted data for this annual status assessment; but we also note that action may be required to assure that a minority of facilities failing to submit this essential data, as required by the Legislature, do so in the future. We are happy to assist agencies that are having difficulty in those regards.

The purpose of this report is to assist decision makers in the health care sector, in government, and in the Legislature to effectively plan for and provide needed high-quality and essential health care and residential and social support services for Hawaii residents.

Finally, we welcome comments or questions about the report, and appreciate suggestions for ways it can be improved upon in the future.
