Plan Development Committee	T. Abe Carapelho reviewed the purpose and goals of the HONSAC-PDC. Emphasis placed on updating priorities. The priorities to be included in the next version of the Health Services and Facilities Plan.

	A brief discussion followed.	
Priorities	Framework. T. Abe Carapelho suggested creating a standardized criteria for selecting priorities. Thereafter the framework will be presented for approval by the Statewide Health Coordinating Council-Plan Development Committee. Thereafter, the approved standardized criteria will be disseminated to all Subarea Health Councils to utilize when updating their regional specific priorities.	T. Abe Carapelho and W. Nihoa will meet to draft criteria to share at the next meeting.
	A discussion followed. Members mentioned various topics impacting priorities: drug/substance use; homelessness; heath disparities; provider shortages; access; individuals under/uninsured, etc. It was suggested a draft criteria be prepared for review and discussion at the next meeting.
