Subarea Health Planning Councils (SACs)

Hawaii The Hawaii County Subarea Health Planning Council meeting scheduled for

November 21, 2023, was cancelled. The next meeting is scheduled for

Honolulu The Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council (HONSAC) met on

Kupuna The inaugural Kupuna Advisory Council (KAC) meeting occurred on

November 2, 2023. Updates on SHPDA'S 2023-2024 priorities and

legislative requests were provided. SHPDA announced its intent to apply, in collaboration with the Hawaii MedQUEST Division, to the CMS AHEAD grant. The priorities of the KAC were discussed and the need to rank priorities was mentioned, as such, members will undergo the PDC approved Prioritization

Process. The next meeting is scheduled for December 8, 2023.

Universal Access

The inaugural Universal Access Advisory Council (UAAC) meeting occurred on November 16, 2023. Updates on SHPDA'S 2023-2024 priorities and legislative requests were provided. SHPDA announced its intent to apply, in collaboration with the Hawaii MedQUEST Division, to the CMS AHEAD grant. Members discussed the key concerns of the UACC. A survey will be administered to members to capture member expertise, identify key concerns relating to universal access and determine future meeting agenda items. The next meeting is scheduled for December 20, 2023.

Health System Reform

SHPDA has been moving at warp speed on Health System Reform. We are developing a legislative strategy to uplevel SHPDA's ability to become the health care oversight agency for the state, including for Long Term Care. Our new Advisory Councils on Keiki Health, Kupuna Health, Health Data, and Universal Access are meeting regularly and gathering background data and establishing priorities. Their deliberation will be used to help inform the CMMI/CMS federal AHEAD grant proposal development process and the Universal Access Council could serve as part of the governance requirement for the AHEAD grant with the addition of the Insurance Commissioner and MedQUEST. SHPDA is reaching out to all acute care and critical access hospitals statewide, to all insurance payers, and to the physician and provider communities, including NQHCs and rural health providers, to get feedback and enlist participation in the AHEAD grant proposal, which is due March 18, 2024. The Hawaii Health Data Center board which oversees the All-Payers Claims Database (APCD) will meet in January to advance our state's ability to track health status monitoring and population health. And we are working with the Kupuna Legislative Caucus on their master plan for improving elder health in Hawai'i.
