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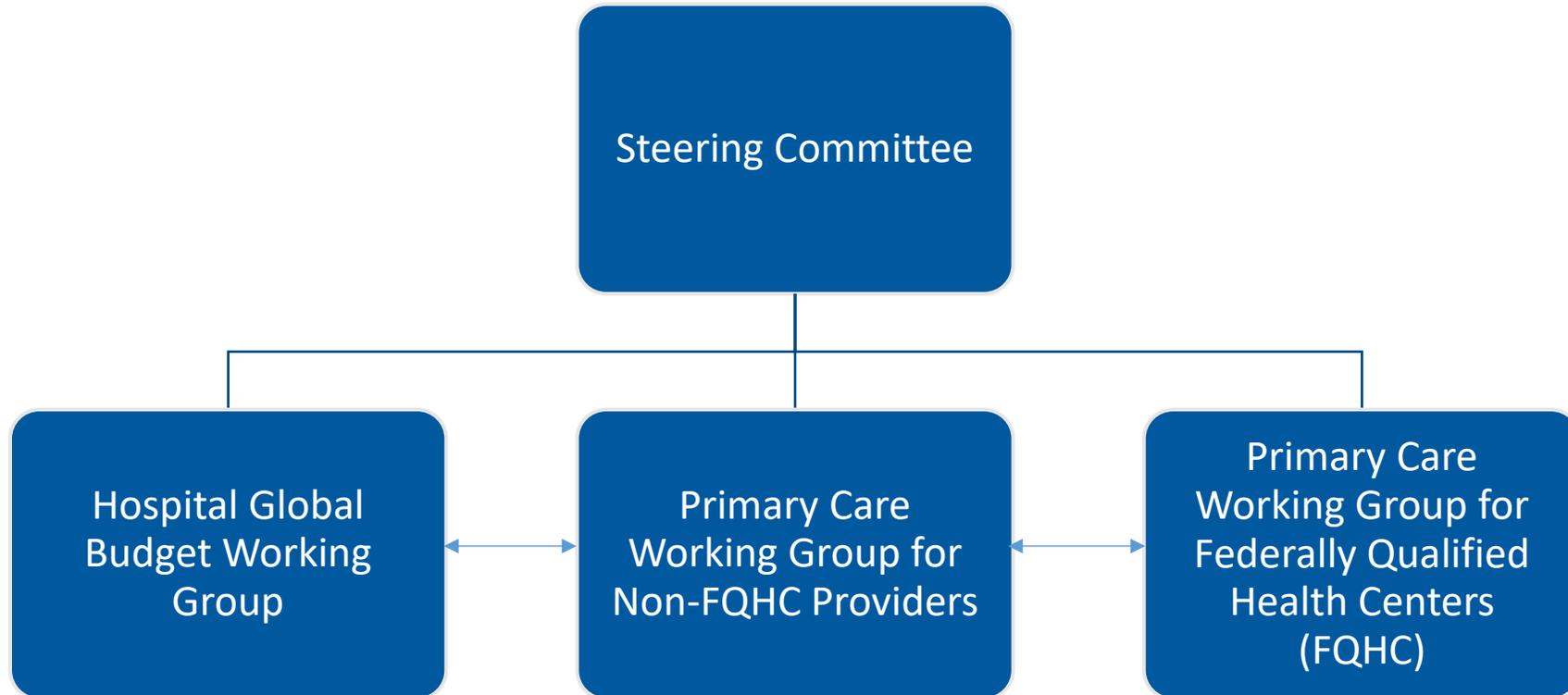

Feedback

Issue

- One of the challenges Primary Care Providers (PCP) face is not having a “payer-agnostic” data system/platform that allows providers to identify care gaps, monitor quality targets, enhance care coordination, etc.
- "Payer-agnostic" in healthcare refers to a system, service, or approach that is designed to be independent of the specific health insurance payer. It means that the system or service can work with any health plan, and the patient's insurance type does not affect the care or service they receive.

Question

- How do PCPs identify care gaps, address quality targets, enhance care coordination, etc. now?

UPDATE ON TIMELINE AND MILESTONES



CY Q3 2025

- Hawai`i AHEAD continues stakeholder engagement, refining model/methodologies, and recruiting providers
- Med-QUEST Division submits regulatory change proposal for Medicaid Alternative Payment Methodology (APM) to CMMI and CMCS (9/1/25)
- MQD executes contract for additional support for PC for all lines of business (Medicaid, Medicare, Commercial, etc.)

CY Q4 2025

- Hawai`i AHEAD continues stakeholder engagement, refining model/methodologies, and recruiting providers
- Hawai`i AHEAD submits draft HGB and PC methodologies to CMMI (12/31/25)

CY Q1 2026

- Hawai`i AHEAD continues stakeholder engagement, recruiting providers, and preparing for implementation

CY Q2 2026

- Hawai`i AHEAD signs cooperative agreement with CMMI that creates framework for partnership and memorializes Hawai`i's model including targets and TCOC methodology (no later than 06/30/26)
- SHPDA executes contract(s) for TCOC support
- SHPDA executes contract(s) for support for recruitment and implementation for PC

CY Q3-4 2026

- Hawai`i AHEAD continues stakeholder engagement, recruiting providers, and preparing for implementation
- Hawai`i AHEAD submits provider participant lists to Medicaid and Medicare

CY Q1 2027

- Performance Year 1 starts on 01/01/27
