

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Administrator's Message

September 2025

Aloha to all. The State Health Planning and Development Agency (SHPDA) is pleased to present this Healthcare Utilization Report for the Year 2024. The report presents current data on healthcare utilization and availability from both public and private healthcare providers, including but not limited to acute care, long-term care, and behavioral health facilities in Hawai'i.

This fulfills one of SHPDA's legislatively mandated responsibilities to collect up-to-date and accurate data on access to and usage of healthcare services statewide. This is necessary for assuring appropriate future availability of and planning for high-quality and adequate healthcare services and infrastructure for Hawai'i. There is a lot of anticipated changes coming to healthcare here. The Department of Human Services (DHS) Med-QUEST Division and SHPDA jointly applied for and were selected in 2024 as one of six states to receive the CMS "AHEAD" grant (The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services Innovation Center "Advancing ALL-Payer Health Efficiency Approaches and Development"), which will be in "Pre-Implementation" planning until January 2028, and then in full implementation from 2028 through 2035. We have two new federally funded staff coming board by September 2025 to support the AHEAD grant activities. Hawaii's aging population, workforce shortages, barriers in access to care, and rising costs for healthcare will require an evolving healthcare delivery system which considers geographic population and service needs changes, technological innovation, affordability, and an adequate workforce. The workforce shortages are adversely affecting our entire healthcare environment, and particularly acute and long-term care, physician/clinician access and rural areas of the state. This legislatively mandated SHPDA inventory of facilities and services is more important than ever.

We greatly appreciate all those many facilities that submitted data as required for this annual status assessment; we had nearly 100% reporting this past year, for which we are grateful, but we are also happy to assist agencies that are having difficulty in meeting our reporting requirements.

The purpose of this report is to assist decision makers in the healthcare sector, in government, and in the Legislature to effectively plan for and provide needed high-quality and essential healthcare and residential and social support services for Hawaii residents. SHPDA, in partnership with Med-QUEST and the University of Hawai'i, is also preparing to launch the All-Payer Claims Database (APCD) in mid-2026, and we need to make sure we are receiving mandated data from all sources for monitoring of population health, access to care, and affordability as well. SHPDA now also receives mandatory prior authorization reporting form all insurers starting in 2025.

Finally, we welcome comments or questions about the report; and we appreciate suggestions for ways it can be improved upon in the future.

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


Figure 1. Number of Acute Care Admissions by County, 2015–2024

Figure 2. Number of Long-Term Care Admissions by County, 2015–2024





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Figure 3. Average Length of Stay for Acute Care by County, 2015–2024





Figure 4. Average Length of Stay for Long-Term Care by County, 2015–2024





Figure 5. Occupancy Rates for Acute Care by County, 2015–2024





Figure 8. Average Daily Census for Long-Term Care by County, 2015–2024



"Acute" bed services

means those inpatient services provided to patients whose average length of stay is usually less than thirty days.

"Acute/long term swing bed" services

means those acute or long term services which are provided through beds which have been designated to serve either acute or long term inpatients.

"Acute psychiatric" services

means twenty-four hour inpatient acute care services for mentally disordered patients whose length of stay is usually less than thirty days.

Admissions

refer to the number of inpatients admitted by the respective facility and bed type. It includes multiple admissions by an individual admitted more than once during the reporting period.

Average daily census (ADC)

is the average number of inpatients on a single day during the reporting period. The ADC is calculated by dividing the number of inpatient days by 365.

Average length of stay (ALOS)

is the average number of days a patient stays in the facility. The ALOS is computed by dividing the total patient days by the number of admissions.

The ALOS may indicate whether a facility is able to appropriately discharge patients from the facility or to another type of bed based on the patient's condition. It may also indicate the proportion of very seriously ill patients the facility cares for. Usually, the larger the number of very sick patients, the longer the ALOS.

The data includes patient days that result from being unable to discharge patients due to a lack of available services in the community or beds needed at other facilities. If these "waitlisted days" were excluded from the ALOS data, it would provide better accurate data on how many days are needed to care for patients and result in a lower ALOS.

County

means one of four major counties: (1) Hawaii County is composed of the island of Hawaii; (2) Honolulu County is composed of the island of Oahu and the City of Honolulu (Census County Division, or CCD) on Oahu and is the most populous city in the state; (3) Kauai County is composed of the island of Kauai; and (4) Maui County is composed of the islands of Maui, Molokai, and Lanai.

"Critical care" services

means those services which provide maximum observation and support of vital functions and definitive therapy for patients with acute but reversible life-threatening impairments of single or multiple vital organ systems.

Inpatient days

are the total number of days a patient stays in a facility. The totals currently include "waitlisted days", i.e. patient days as a result of not being able to discharge a patient due to lack of community services or other types of beds appropriate for the care of the patient.

"Intermediate care facility (ICF)"

means an "Intermediate care facility" as defined in section 11-94-2, HAR.

"Intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID)"

means an intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disabilities as defined in 42 Code of Federal Regulations section 440.150 (a).

Licensed beds

means the approved bed capacity as determined by the Office of Health Care Assurance (OHCA) for the State of Hawaii.

Occupancy rate (Occup %)

is the percentage of licensed bed capacity occupied on average. Occupancy rates are calculated by dividing the ADC by the number of licensed beds and multiplying by 100.

Health care facilities require some excess capacity to efficiently manage admissions, discharged and transfers of patients. If, however, the occupancy rate is low for long periods of time, the facility may not be able to generate sufficient revenue to justify staffing and other expenses for this additional capacity.

In acute care, particularly where patients are admitted on a non-scheduled basis, e.g. OB, CCU, etc., optimal occupancy must accommodate unforeseen increases in admissions. Consequently, occupancy rates may occasionally exceed 100% because of an unexpected surge in number of admissions. This might also occur if there is a decrease in routine patient discharges. Chronic high occupancy rates will decrease the number of beds available to the community.

Lack of qualified staffing and temporary closure of patient areas because of facility renovations, labor shortages and strikes may also prevent making more beds available.

"Psychiatric" services

means services for the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness or mental disorder in persons.

Example. Suppose a facility reported that for their 150 licensed beds there were 6,000 admissions and 40,000 total inpatient days for the year then:

1. Average Length of Stay (ALOS)

- = Total Inpatient Days/Admissions
- = 40,000 Days/6,000 Admissions
- = 6.67 or 7 Days

2. Average Daily Census (ADC)

- = Total Inpatient Days/365 Days
- = 40,000 Days/365 Days
- = 109.59 or 110 Beds

3. Occupancy Rate (Occup %)

- = (Average Daily Census/Licensed Beds) X 100
- = (109.59/150) X 100
- = 0.7306 X 100
- = 73.06%
