Mattress Recycling Council MRC At-A-Glance



2015 – First state, Connecticut

Visible consumer fee: CA \$10.50 / CT \$11.75 / RI \$20.50

Collection Networks: More than 300 locations

Transportation: 15,000 loads annually

Recyclers: 14 facilities

Education: consumers and industry audiences

Research: \$1 million annually

Collection, transportation and recycling functions – all outsourced



Mattress Recycling Council Where to Recycle



Retailer take-back programs – Varies by state and retailer

Commercial Volume Program – Direct service to retailers, hotels, colleges, military and healthcare

Curbside pick-up – Varies by solid waste contract

No-cost drop-off sites – Transfer stations, landfills, non-profits

Collection events – Rural, underserved, environmental justice areas

Direct recycling facility drop off – No volume limits

Mattress Recycling Council Research Projects



Over 30 completed projects

- Collection Improve unit quality and decrease handling times
- **Transportation** Units per trailer, alternative containers, decrease carbon impacts
- Deconstruction Lean manufacturing, fire safety assessments, automation
- End market development New and alternative uses
- LCA Life Cycle Analysis



Mattress Recycling Council Life Cycle Analysis

Why?

- Mature California program:
 - -76% recovery rate by recyclers
 - -80% statewide landfill diversion, 1.6M units recycled
 - -Reliable data across the program
- Scope: CA collection, transport, recycling, end markets, disposal

Results?

- Favorable!
- Foam and steel reuse/recycling driving environmental benefits
- Widely distributed in environmental press






Mattress Recycling Council Life Cycle Analysis

Greenhouse gas emissions savings similar to driving **60** fewer miles.



Life Cycle Analysis: Incurred and Displaced Impacts






