<u>Education</u>	<u>Experience and Other Requirements</u>
M.D. or D.O. licensed to practice in Hawaii.	Certified in anatomical or clinical pathology by the American Board of Pathology or the American Osteopathic Board of Pathology.
M.D. or D.O. licensed to practice in Hawaii.	Certified by American Board of Medical Microbiology, American Board of Clinical Chemistry, American Board of Bioanalysis, American Board of Medical Laboratory Immunology, or other national certification board approved by the director of health in one of the clinical lab specialties.
For the subspecialty of oral pathology only, M.D. or D.O. licensed to practice in Hawaii.	Certified by the American Board of Oral Pathology, American Board of Pathology, or the American Osteopathic Board of Pathology.
Ph.D. or doctoral degree from an accredited college or university in one of the chemical, physical, or biological sciences or public health.	Certified by American Board of Medical Microbiology, American Board of Clinical Chemistry, American Board of Bioanalysis, American Board of Medical Laboratory Immunology, or other national certification board approved by the director of health in one of the clinical lab specialties. AND 2 years or experience in one or more of the clinical laboratory specialties including at least one year of clinical lab supervisory experience in a laboratory acceptable to the Department.
