## Specimen Requirements for Leptospira Culture in Clinical Samples

Test:

Leptospira culture

Specimen receiving:

Specimens for *Leptospira* culture will be accepted Monday through Friday From 7:45 am – 4:00 pm. KDHL is closed on weekends and holidays.

Turn around time:

6-7 weeks

Specimen requirements:

Blood, urine or CSF must be inoculated by the submitting lab in EMJH media (pre-requested from KDHL). If using anticoagulant tubes (i.e. vacutainer), use heparin or EDTA, not citrated tubes.

Specimen collection:

Blood and CSF should be collected within the first 10 days of illness. After the first week of illness, urine may be a better source of *Leptospira*, however it is recommended that blood be cultured in all cases of suspected leptospirosis regardless of the date of onset.

Specimen inoculation:

Submitting lab must inoculate EMJH media prior to submission. (Please contact KDHL at 241-3353 for EMJH media)

- BLOOD: Inoculate one, two and three drops of blood into three tubes of EMJH.
- CSF: Inoculate 0.5 mL of CSF to one tube of EMJH.
- URINE: Immediately after collection, centrifuge 10 12 mL of urine @ 1500 rpm for 5 minutes. Decant supernatant and inoculate one, two, and three drops of the resuspended sediment into three tubes of EMJH.

## DO NOT REFRIGERATE INOCULATED TUBES. STORE EMJH TUBES AT ROOM TEMPERATURE AND IN THE DARK.

Specimen transport:

Specimens should be transported at ambient temperature to the laboratory. They should be securely sealed with parafilm to prevent leakage, and wrapped in aluminum foil to create a darkened environment. Tubes should be upright during transport.

Requisition form:

All specimens must be submitted with a legible 81.3 request form and include:

- Patient name and another unique identifier
  - Name of test requested
  - Date of collection AND date of onset
  - Submitter name and address
  - Inclusion of patient symptomology would be desirable.

Normal value:

Negative for Leptospira at 6 weeks.

Result notification:

Final laboratory reports will be forwarded to the submitter. A positive finding will be called in to the submitting laboratory. The report will be forwarded to both the submitting laboratory and the KDHO Disease Investigation Unit.

Comments:

EMJH media can be pre-requested from KDHL by a submitting laboratory.

All positive cultures will be forwarded to State Laboratories on Oahu for confirmation and to determine serovar.

Unacceptable conditions:

Criteria for sample rejection include the following:

- Specimens are not inoculated in EMJH media
- Leaking specimens
- Contaminated or overgrown specimens
- Illegible or incomplete requisition forms
- Specimens have been refrigerated
- Specimens not labeled properly
- Improperly collected specimens
