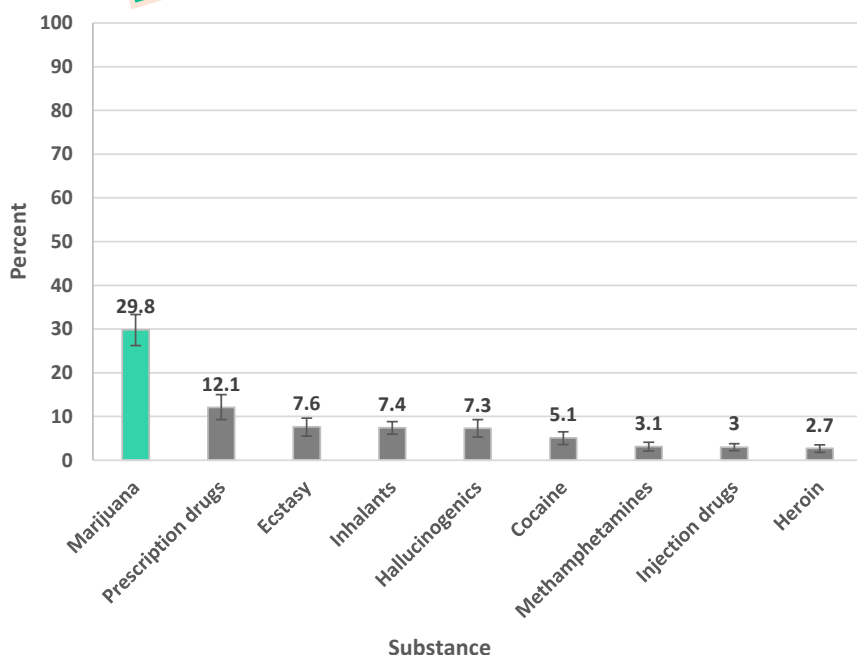


# Youth Substance Use: Honolulu County

2017 Hawai'i State Epidemiological Outcomes Workgroup



More youth have used **marijuana** during their lifetime than *any other substance* (2015 YRBS).



## 25.3%

of Honolulu County youth have been **offered, sold, or received** an illegal drug on **school property** in the last year.

Compared to  
**21.7% in the US!**  
(2015 YRBS)

## How do we change this?

1. *Enhance* protective factors and reduce risk factors.
2. *Tailor* the program to the specific population, considering age, gender, and ethnicity.
3. Family-based prevention programs should enhance *family bonding* and include parenting skills.

### Related *Risk* Factors:

**Exposure** to substance use and **community norms** can **increase** use in our youth!
