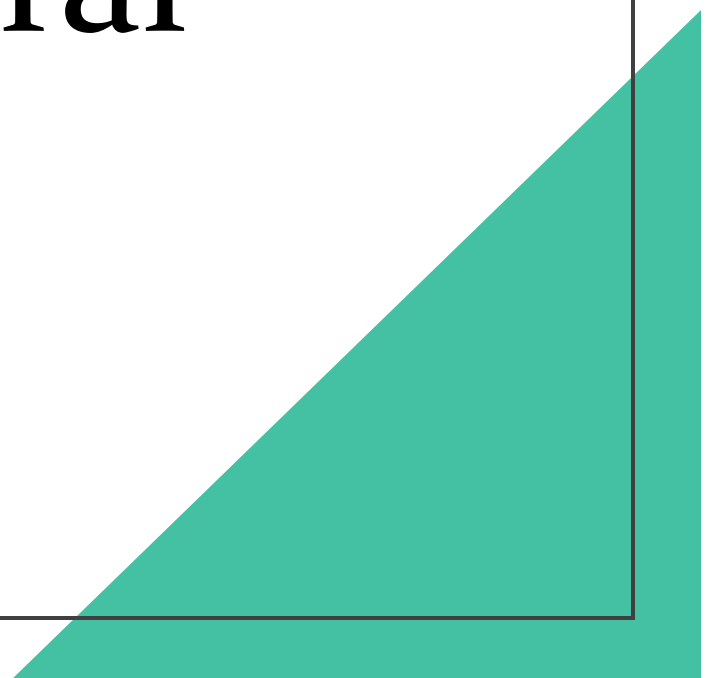

My highlight was meeting Uncle Ron Ebarra, a Lahaina displaced kūpuna who shared that what we were doing was exactly what he needed. "THIS is what we need, aloha and meeting those who get us and share healing in the ways that feel homely" Uncle Ron from Lahaina Music Missions

Today we sat with one kane who has been going through a lot. He stayed with us from 9am-1pm sharing his mo'olelo and mele. At the end of the day he shared that he hadn't played ukulele and sang outside since surviving a stroke in 2019. He smiled and said, "You don't know how much this means to me and how healing this was. I think I may open my patio doors when I play ukulele tonight."

"I don't normally open up like this but you all make me feel so comfortable. I believe we were meant to meet each other and sing together. "

"Having the MACC Aunties (Teaching Artists) has helped our keiki find joy in the world around them! Especially connecting to this place we call home."

" Today we got to sing and play ukulele with a Tutu and other kūpuna while her mo'opuna made lei's, danced hula and drew their art on our community mural. It was day of intergenerational connections. "

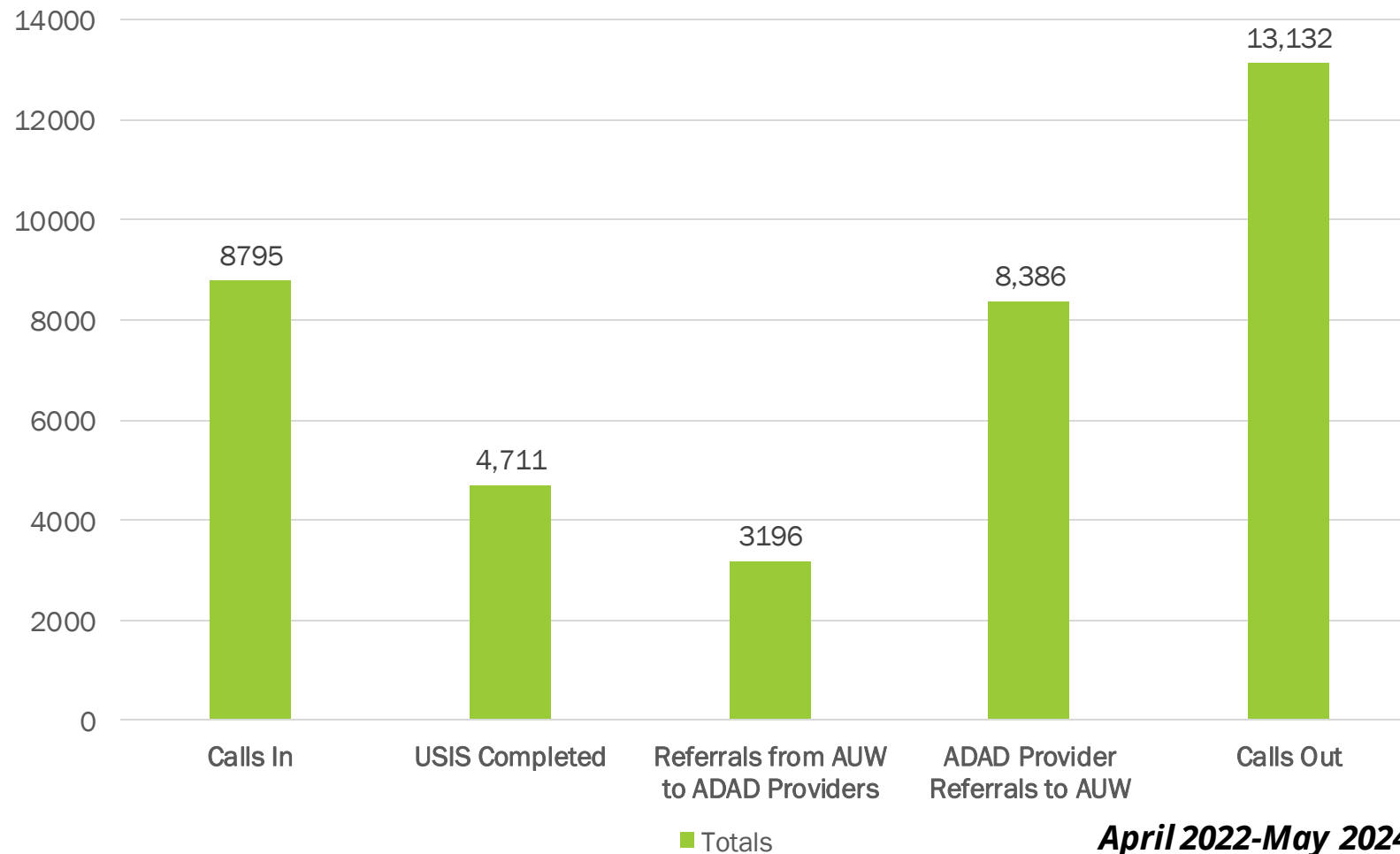




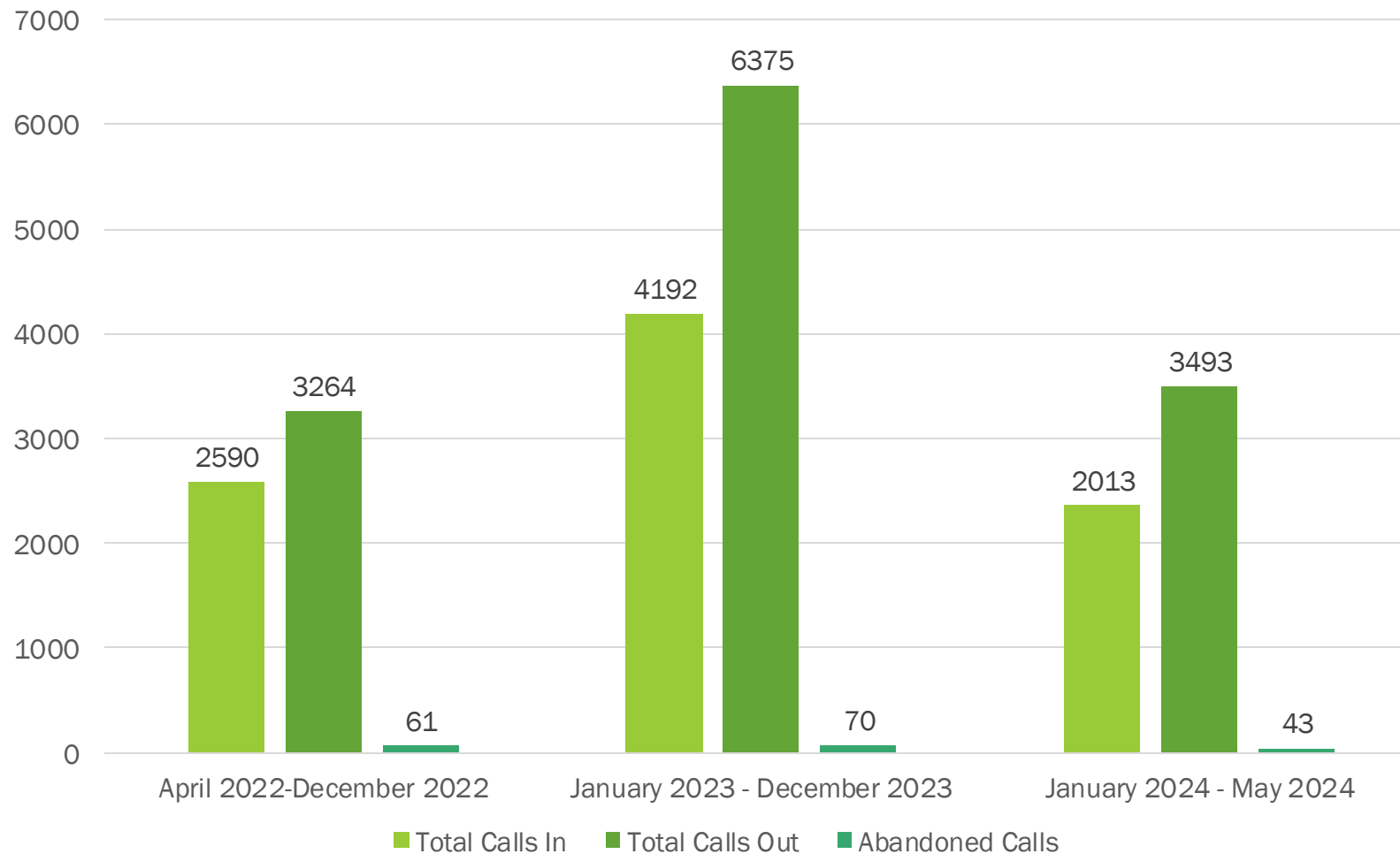

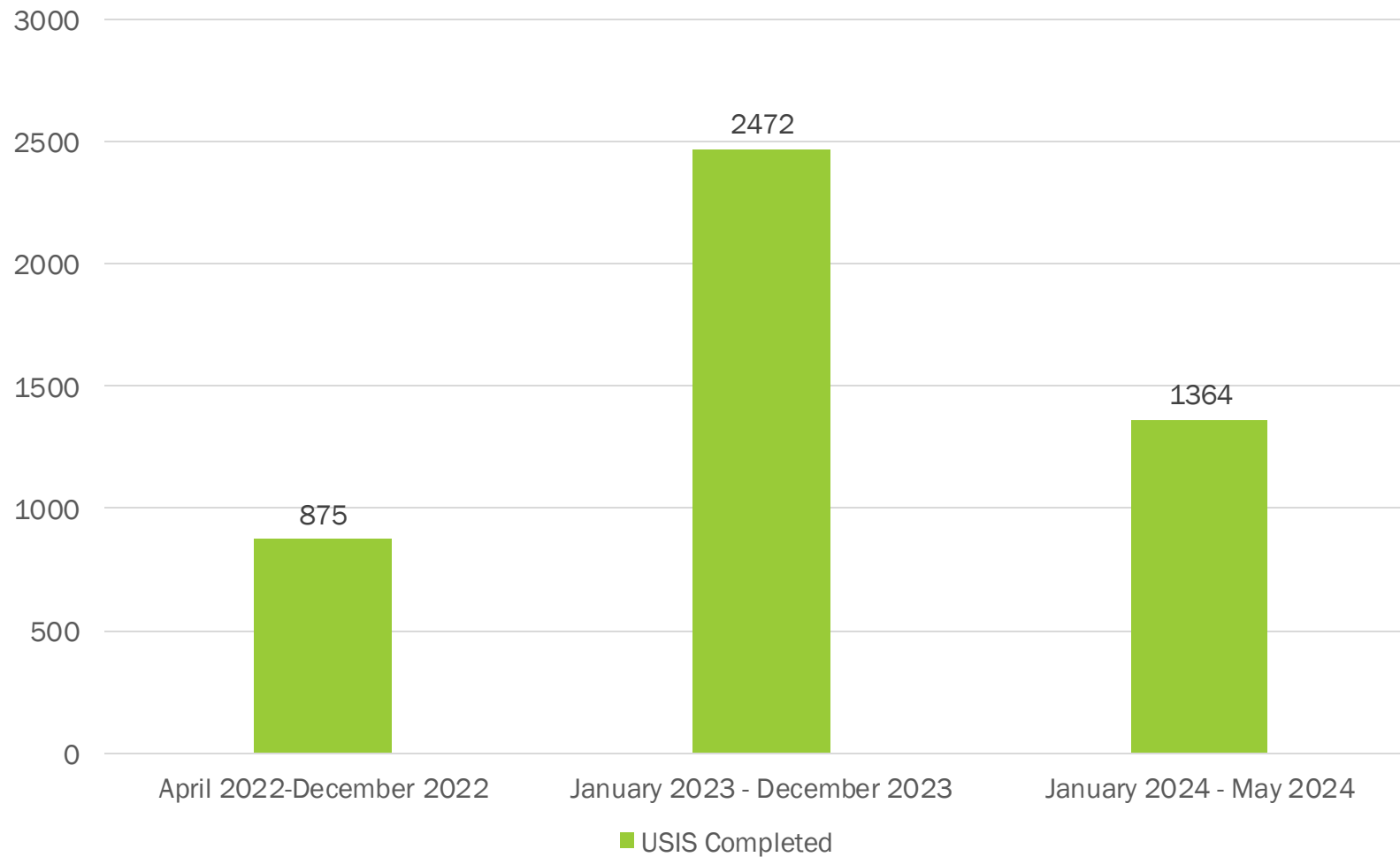


# Historical Call Volume



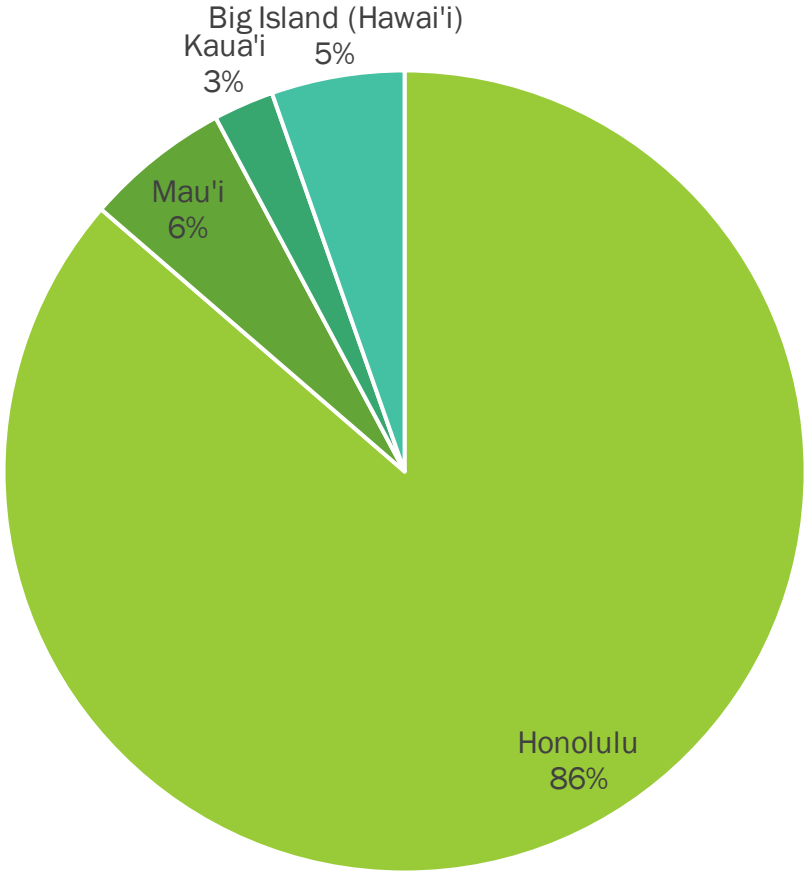


# Historical USIS Completed



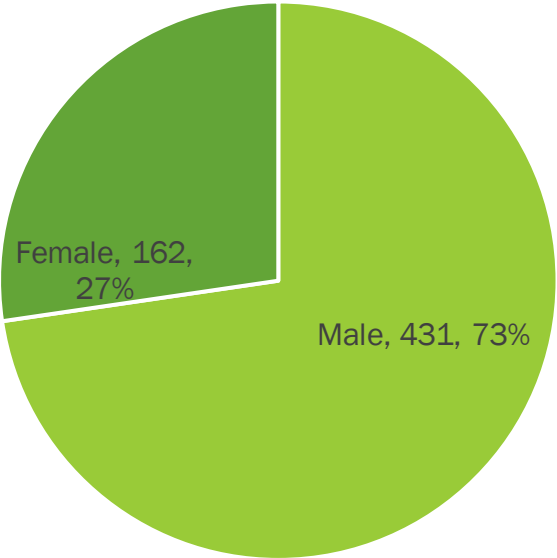

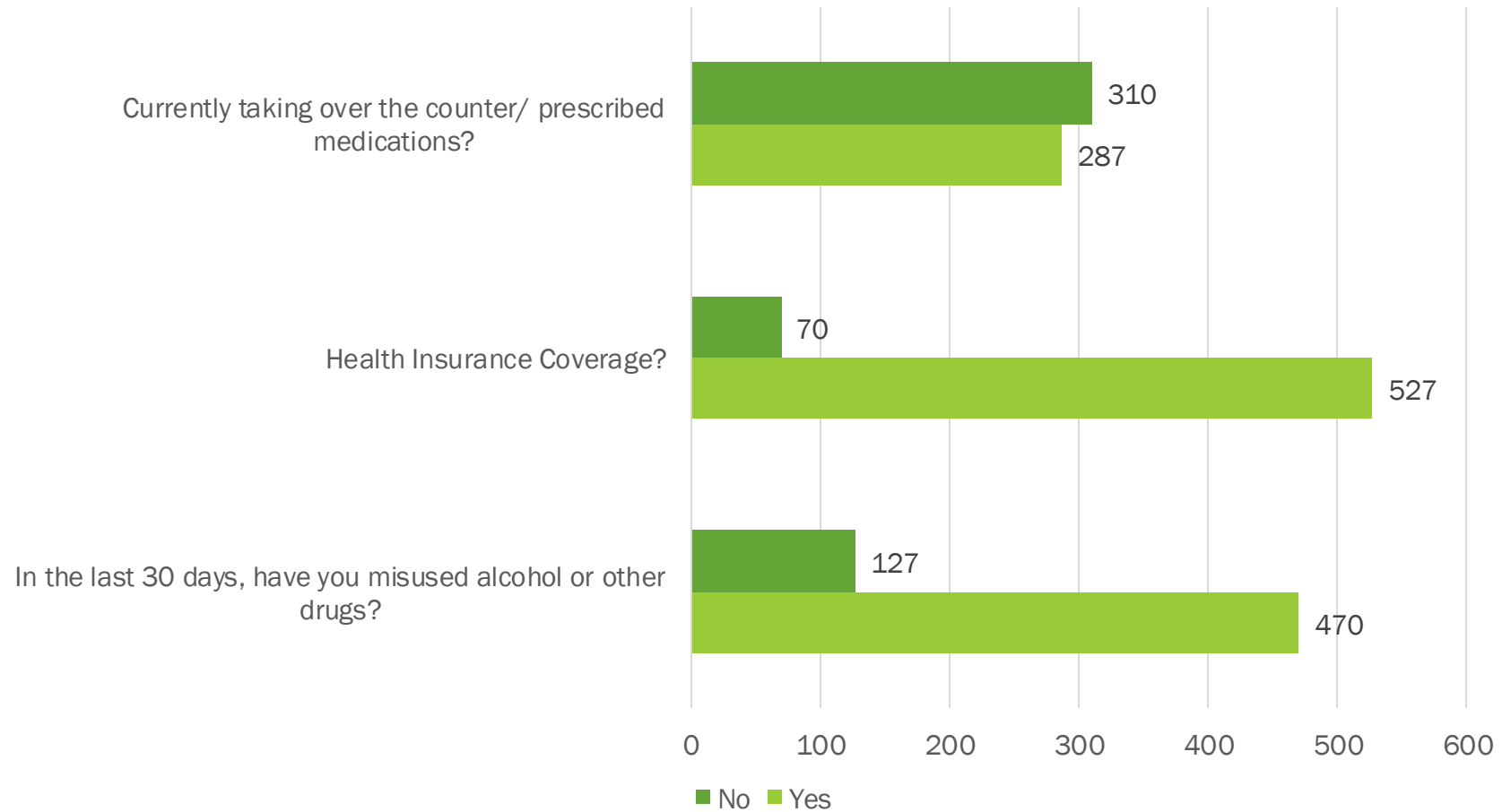

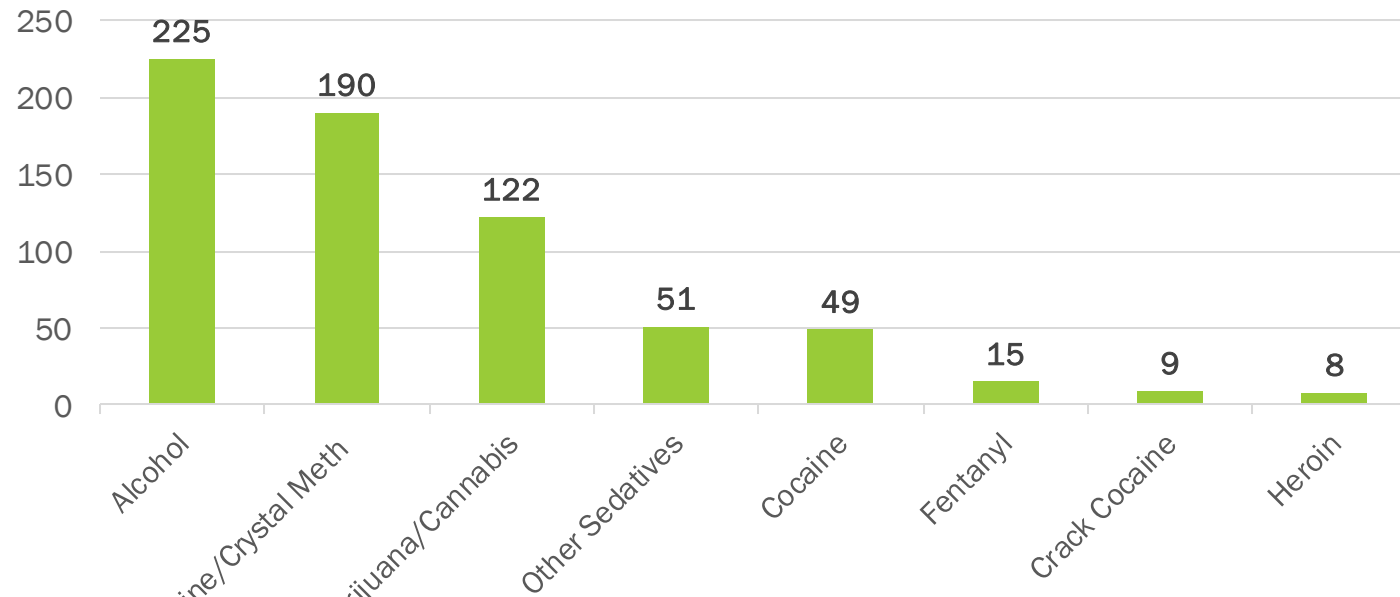

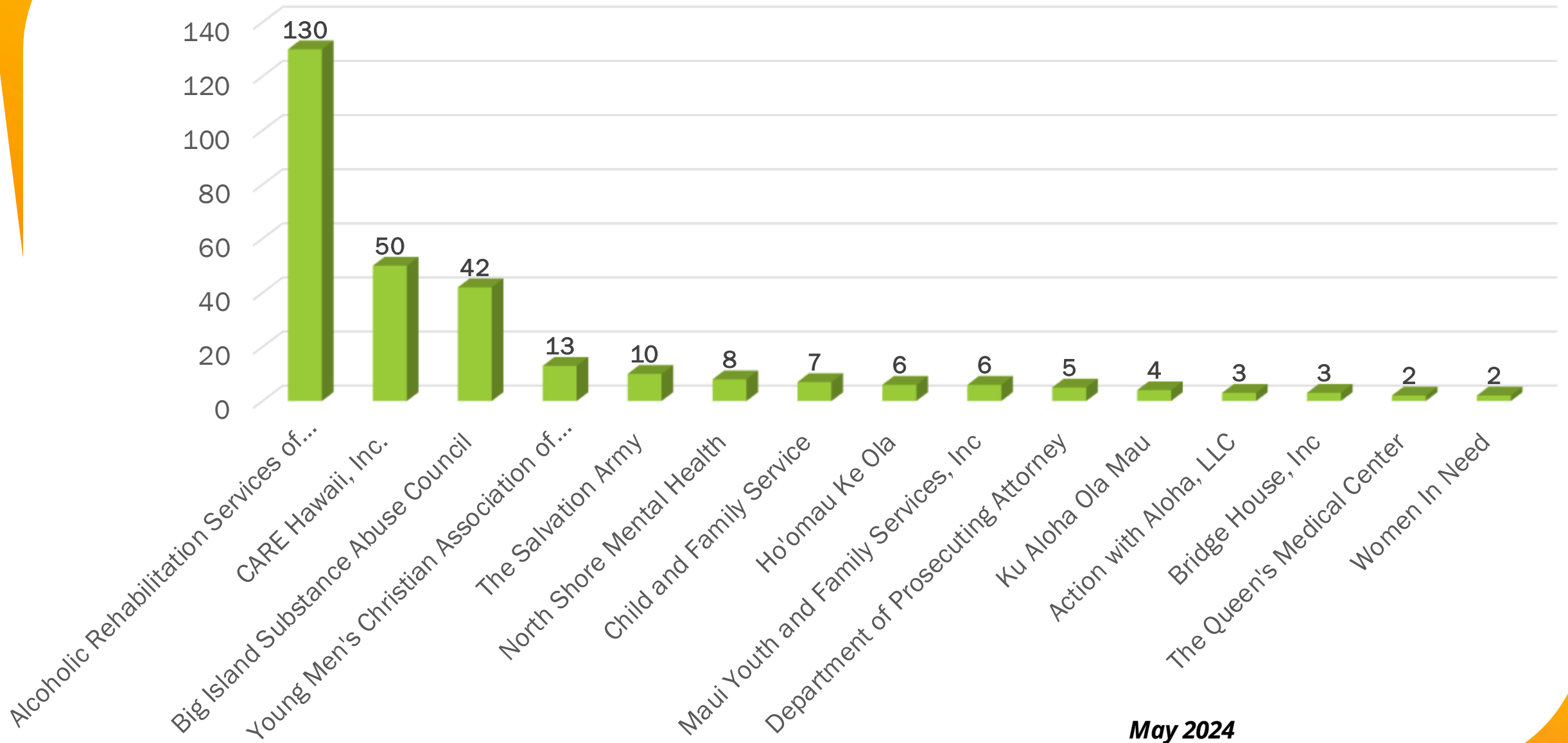
# Substances Use In The Last 30 Days (Select All That Apply)

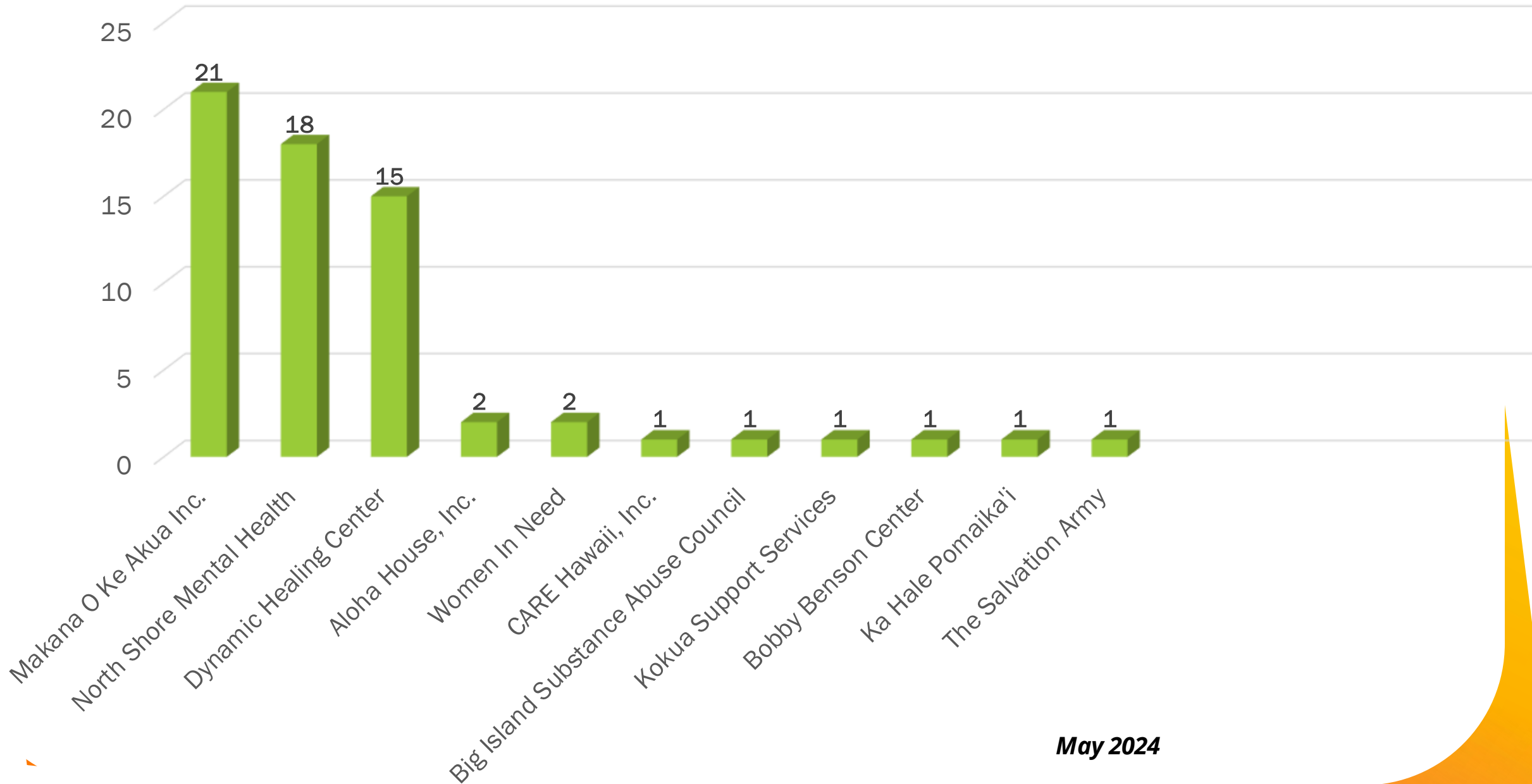

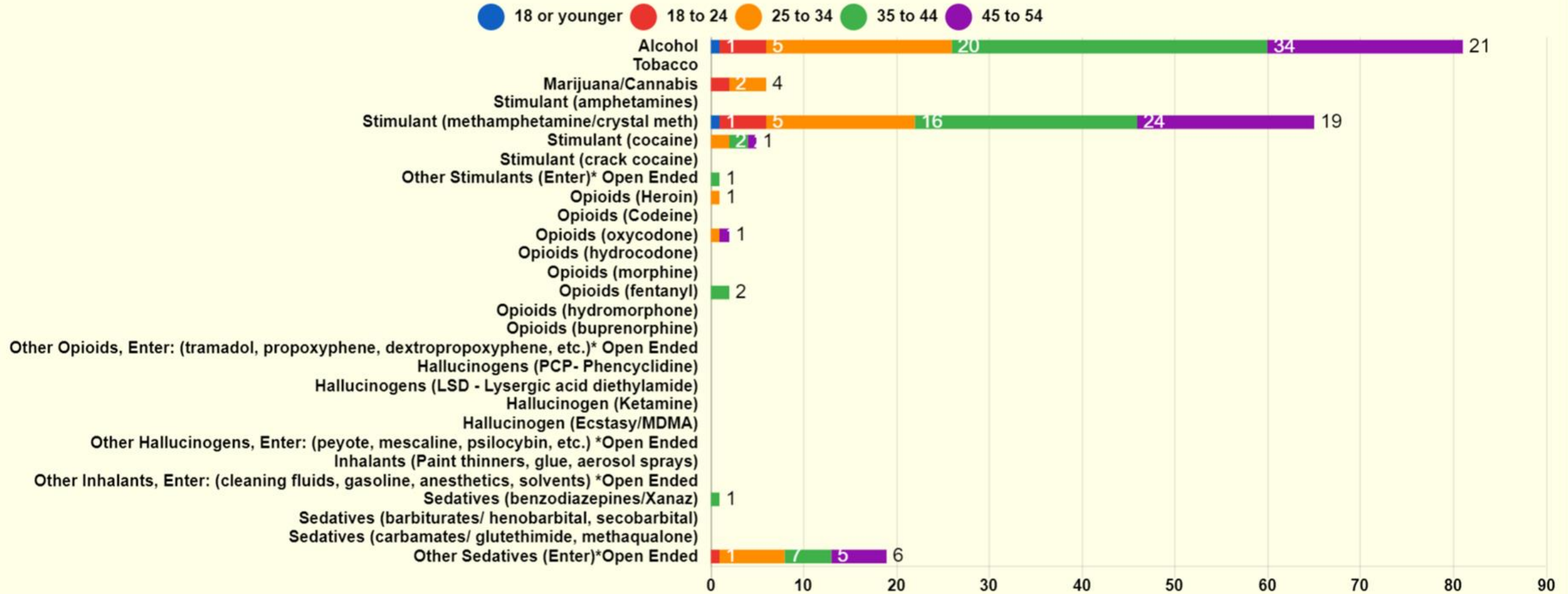
