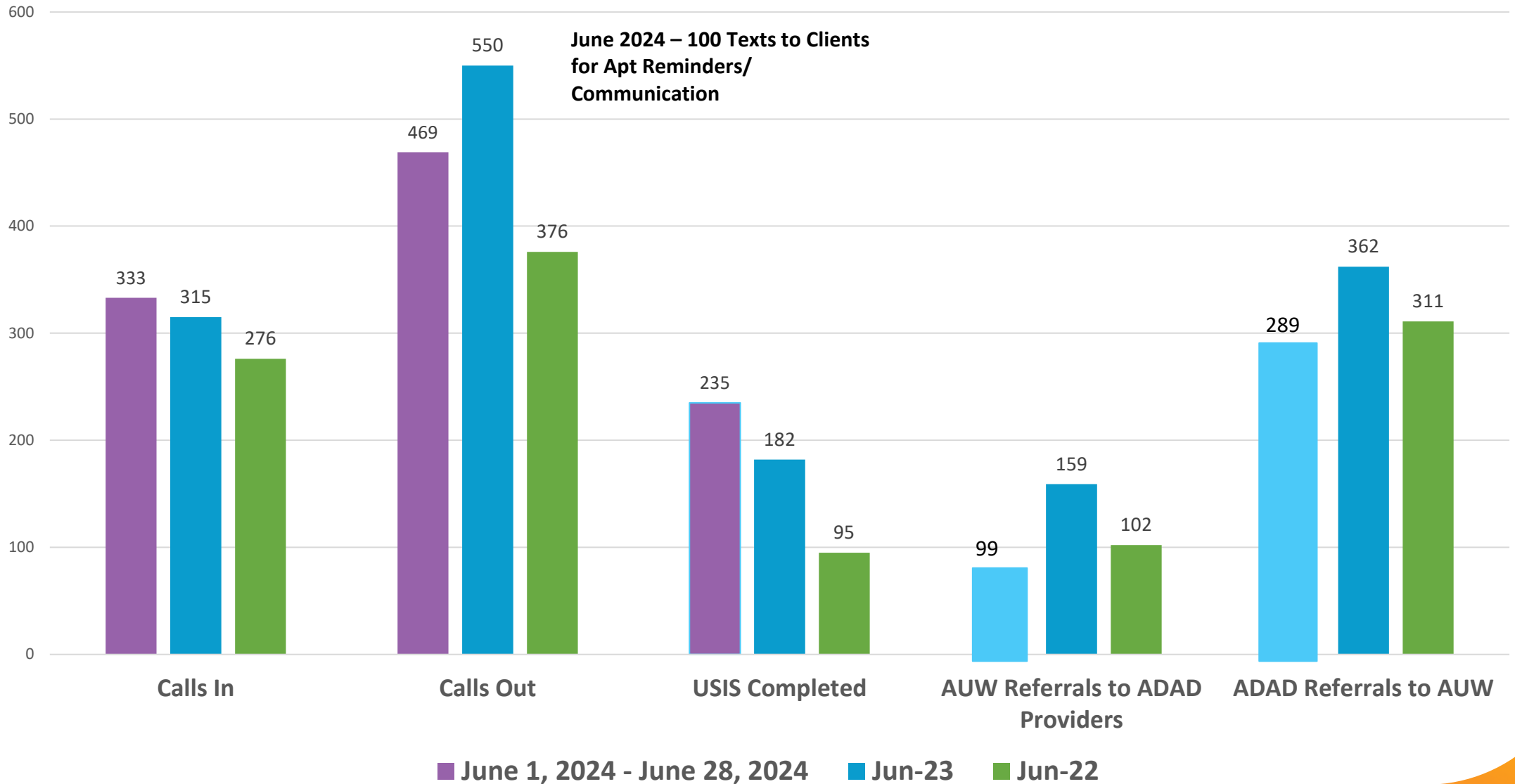

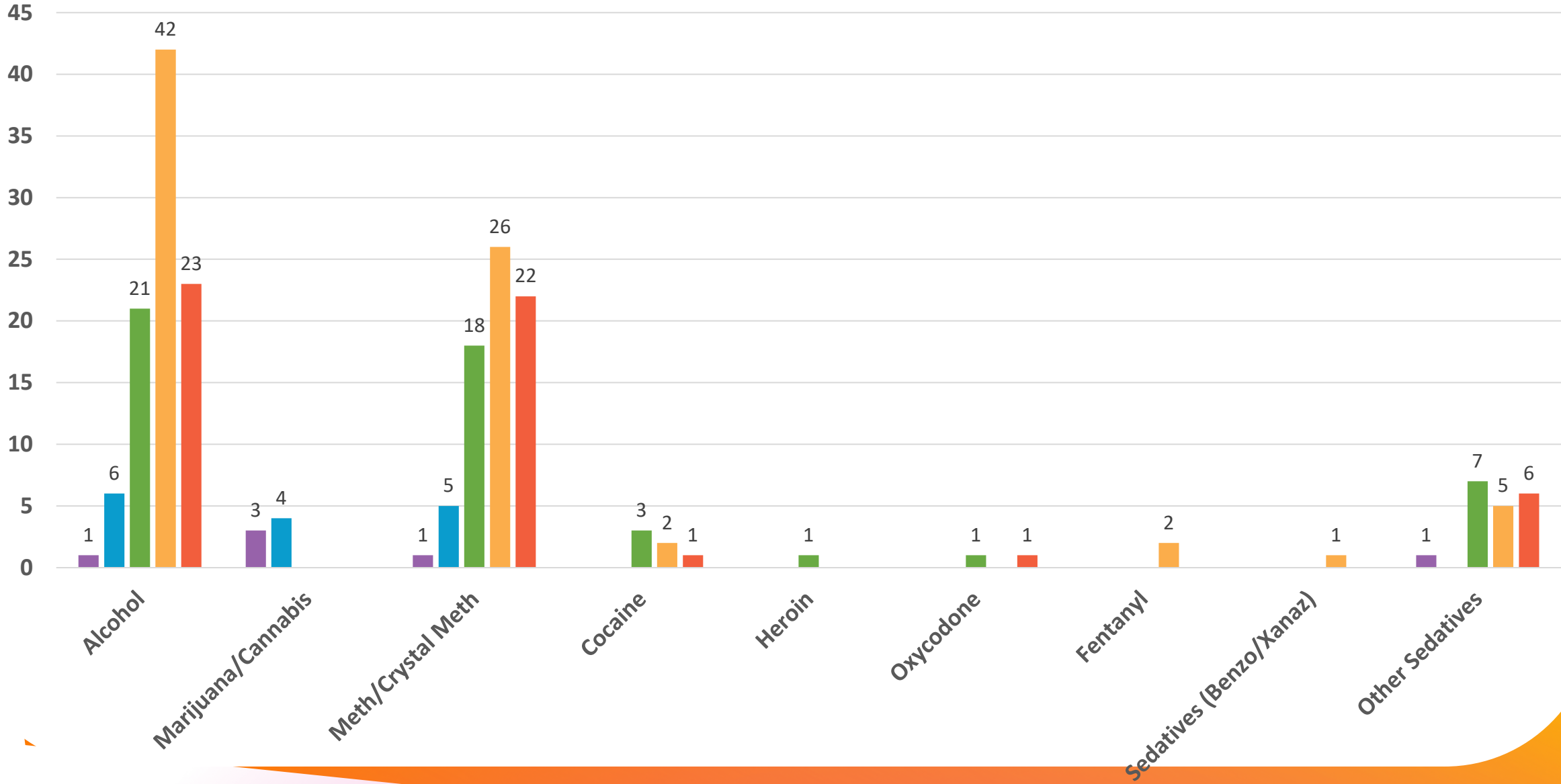
Seasonal Call & Referral SUD Data
