Family Management

- Improved family communication, problem-solving, and cooperation
- Youth learn and establish a role within the family
- Reduce stress in family life, increase harmony
- Goal setting, increased household cohesion; reduction in disciplinary actions

Youth Outcomes

- Increased work ethic; Increased hopefulness; Increased ability to manage stress
- Improved effort in school, grades
- Develop passion for learning
- Increased sense of self efficacy, self-esteem; Learn concepts and skills
- Improve understanding of self and others



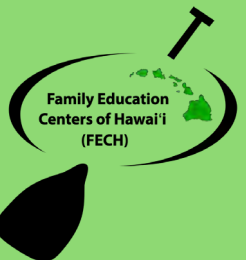
ASSESSMENT

Youth

- Alienated, unstructured free time
- Lax attitudes towards drug and alcohol use
- Native Hawaiian, or 2 or more ethnicities with Native Hawaiian at increased risk
- Youth spend less time in nature, increased screentime

Family

- Minimal social networks
- Families of low-income
- Language barriers
- Single parent households
- Families that spend little time together
