





TB-Related Deaths and Death Rates Hawaii, 2014–2023








Percent of TB Cases by Age Group and Gender Hawaii vs. United States











TB Cases by Major Site of Disease Hawaii, 2023





Primary Anti-TB Drug Resistance¹ Hawaii, 2014–2023






Trends in HIV Testing Persons with TB Hawaii, 2014–2023


US & Non-US Born Status of All Persons Reported with TB, Hawaii, 2023


